## AN ORDINANCE

Amending several ordinances, in so far as they refer to Section Three, as follows:

An ordinance of the City of San Antonio, passed and approved on the 14th day of December, A.D.1914: which was amended by an ordinance passed and approved on the

29th day of March, 1915: which was amended by an ordinance passed and approved on the 24th day of June, 1915; all of the said ordinances being entitled, "An Ordinance regulating the production, making, manufacture, care, delivery and sale of Registered Milk or Cream, Pasteurized Milk or Cream, Cream, Milk, Skimmed Milk, and Buttermilk, within the limits of the City of San Antonio"

**MB-186** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$1200.00 to purchase automobiles for Police Department.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary be, and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1916 General Fund for the purpose of purchasing automobiles for use of the Police Department.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.
