AN ORDINANCE MA-746

Ordering a special election, to be held in this City on April 1st, 1916.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

WHEREAS THE Honorable Albert Steves has tendered to the Mayor and Commissioners his resignation as Commissioner of Fire and Police of this City, and said resignation was duly accepted and became effective on March 3, A.D. 1916, and is is now desired finally to order a special election to fill the vacancy thus created in said office, and to fix the date and otherwise to provide therefor, Now Therefore be it further ordained that a special election to fill said vacant office shall be held in this City in the several election precincts thereof on Saturday the first day of April, A.D. 1916, for the purpose of electing some duly qualified person to said office of COMMISSIONER OF FIRE AND POLICE in and for said City, which office is now vacant: and for the purposes of said election the polls shall be open in said several election precincts from 8 o'clock A.M. to 7 o'clock P.M. on said date at the respective places, or localities, hereunder designated:

This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom, and the same shall take effect at once.
