

AN ORDINANCE 2011-01-20-0055

**AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO AN AGREEMENT WITH PARENT/CHILD INCORPORATED (PCI) PROVIDING AN AMOUNT UP TO \$11,000.00 FOR THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT TO PROVIDE ORAL HEALTH EVALUATIONS, PREVENTIVE CARE AND DENTAL CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES ON A FEE-FOR-SERVICE BASIS FOR CHILDREN FROM BIRTH TO AGE THREE YEARS AND EXPECTANT MOTHERS ENROLLED IN THE PCI EARLY HEAD START PROGRAM FOR THE TERM FEBRUARY 1, 2011 THROUGH JANUARY 31, 2012.**

**WHEREAS**, Parent/Child Incorporated (PCI), a nonprofit organization, is funded by the United States Department of Health and Human Services' Early Head Start Program to provide a variety of services, including day care, child development, nutrition and social services, health and disability assessment, and parent involvement training to low-income Bexar County families with children under 3 years of age and to expectant mothers; and

**WHEREAS**, since 1993, the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District's Dental Division (Metro Health Dental) has provided fee-for-service dental screenings and clinical treatment for children enrolled in PCI programs; and

**WHEREAS**, families that utilize these services do not have the financial resources to obtain health care on their own; and

**WHEREAS**, Metro Health Dental has assisted in the development of dental health education messages for children and their families; and

**WHEREAS**, Metro Health Dental has collaborated with PCI and the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio, School of Dental Hygiene, to implement a fluoride varnish program for all PCI enrollees; and

**WHEREAS**, this collaboration has also resulted in establishing a network of private and non-profit dental providers that provide services beyond the scope of Metro Health Dental and serve as the dental homes for children beyond their experience in Early Head Start; and

**WHEREAS**, funding generated through this contract will be utilized to purchase program supplies and fund associated professional services contractors; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to an existing agreement between Parent/Child Incorporated (PCI) and the City of San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) in an amount up to \$11,000.00 for the San Antonio Metropolitan Health

District Dental Division to provide dental services to the PCI Early Head Start program for the period February 1, 2011 through January 31, 2012. A copy of the agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager, or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or his designee is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said contract.

**SECTION 3.** Fund 26012000 entitled "Misc Grant" is hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this contract and the sum of up to \$11,000.00, from PCI and from Medicaid and CHIP billings associated with program activities, will be appropriated in said fund. A formal final budget which will include Internal Order numbers and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon the execution of said contract.


**SECTION 4.** The financial fiscal allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Chief Financial Officer, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage by eight (8) or more affirmative votes of the entire City Council; otherwise, said effective date shall be ten (10) days from the date of passage hereof.







**AMENDMENT TO  
DENTAL SERVICES AGREEMENT**

This amendment is entered into by and between the City of San Antonio, a Texas Municipal Corporation, (hereinafter referred to as "City") acting by and through the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District, (hereinafter referred to as SAMHD), pursuant to Ordinance No. 2011-01-20-\_\_\_ passed and approved on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2011, and Parent/Child Incorporated, (hereinafter referred to as "PCI"), acting by and through its designated representative, Dr. Sharon Small, Chief Executive Officer, both of which may be referred to collectively as "Parties" or singularly as "Party".

The Parties hereto severally and collectively agree, and by the execution hereof are bound, to the mutual obligations herein contained and to the performance and accomplishment of the tasks hereinafter described.

**WHEREAS**, the City entered into a contract with PCI to provide dental services to children in PCI's Early Head Start program pursuant to an Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement") that commenced on February 1, 2010 and terminates on January 1, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties agree that the term of the Agreement should be extended through January 31, 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the City that an amendment of the Agreement now be executed extending the term of the Agreement; **NOW THEREFORE:**

City and the PCI agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Section 4.1 is amended as follows:

4.1 This contract shall commence on February 1, 2011 and shall terminate January 31, 2012 unless extension or earlier termination shall occur pursuant to the terms of this contract.

2. Section 6.2 is amended as follows:


6.2 Fees will be waived for prenatal patients enrolled for Early Head Start services with PCI for services provided by SAMHD, including all periodontal care and available restorative care one year post partum.

3. All other terms, conditions, covenants and provisions of the Agreement are hereby continued and shall remain in effect in their original form, except for the provisions modified by this Amendment.
