SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, HELD IN THE MAYOR'S OFFICE OF THE CITY HALL, AT ELEVEN O'CLOCK, A.M., ON FRIDAY, APRIL 5th, 1946.

PRESENT: Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson; Mayor Mauermann presiding.

The Clerk read the Call, as follows:

April 5th, 1946

To the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio:-

Gentlemen:

By virtue of the authority vested in me by the Charter of the City of San Antonio, I hereby call you in Special Session to be held at 11:00 o'clock, A. M., on April 5th, 1946, in the Mayor's Office of the City Hall of San Antonio, Texas, to consider and act upon the following:

"AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE LEASE WITH UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FOR SITE FOR OUTER MARKER ON BROWNSVILLE-FORT WORTH AIRWAY," and,

for the purpose of discussing and enacting authorization to make application to the Federal Housing Authority for additional housing in the San Antonio area, and especially at Kelly Field.

Following a discussion by the Council, Commissioner Hein introduced the following ordinance, which was passed and approved by roll call vote, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson.

AN ORDINANCE (3249)

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE LEASE WITH UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FOR SITE FOR OUTER MARKER ON BROWNSVILLE-FORT WORTH AIRWAY.

The Mayor stated he had received a letter from Lt. Col. Mount, who also had sent another officer to see him, concerning the need for additional housing for veterans at Kelly Field and the possibility the City might be able to obtain more housing for this purpose. Following a discussion by the Council, Commissioner Anderson introduced the following resolution, which, after a second by Commissioner Hein, was passed and approved by roll call vote, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson.

A RESOLUTION (3250)

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO NEGOTIATE WITH THE FPHA TO SECURE ADDITIONAL HOUSING FOR VETERANS AT KELLY FIELD.

On motion of Commissioner Hein, seconded by Commissioner Callaghan and carried by roll call vote, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson, the meeting adjourned Friday, April 5, 1946.
