

A RESOLUTION

DECLARING THE CANVASS AND THE RESULT OF A SPECIAL ELECTION ON THE 28 OF MAY 1946 TO SUBMIT TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS WHO OWN TAXABLE PROPERTY IN SAID CITY AND WHO HAVE DULY RENDERED THE SAME FOR TAXATION, SEPARATE PROPOSITIONS TO BORROW MONEY ON THE CREDIT OF THE CITY AND TO ISSUE BONDS OF THE CITY FOR PERMANENT PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS IN AND FOR SAID CITY, AS FOLLOWS:- A-46: SANITARY SEWERAGE PLANT AND SYSTEM BONDS, \$3,300,000.00; B-46: STORM SEWERS AND DRAINS, \$1,100,000.00.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-


1. Came on regularly to be canvassed, on this the 29 day of May, 1946, the day after the special election to borrow money on the credit of the City of San Antonio and to issue bonds of the City for permanent public improvements in and for said City, the returns of the special municipal election held on the 28 day of May, 1946, at which election there was submitted to the qualified voters who own taxable property in said City and who have duly rendered the same for taxation, separate propositions to borrow money on the credit of the City and to issue bonds of the City for permanent public improvements in and for said City as fully set out in the Ordinance ordering said election passed and approved on the 30th day of April, 1946 and as set out in the Proclamation and Notice of Election promulgated by the Mayor on the 30th day of April, 1946 posted at the several voting places in the several precincts in said City and published in the Commercial Recorder, as required by law, and the Mayor and Commissioners having met to canvass the returns and to declare the result of said election in the manner provided by law, and after considering, determining and canvassing all the matters of fact thereto appertaining; and,


2. WHEREAS, said returns were canvassed by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, and the result of said election declared at their meeting held in the Council Chamber at the City Hall in said City, on the 29 day of May, 1946, from which it appears that said Proposition A-46, to issue \$3,300,000.00 Sanitary Sewerage Plant and System Bonds of the City of San Antonio was not approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting at said election, and that said Proposition B-46, to issue \$1,100,000.00 Storm Sewers and Drains Bonds of the City of San Antonio was not approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting at said election, the respective votes cast in favor of and against said Propositions to issue bonds of the City of San Antonio, as appears from said returns, and said canvass, being as follows, to-wit:-


"FOR"	-- Proposition A-46, \$3,300,000 Sanitary Sewerage Plant and System Bonds	- 4593 votes
"AGAINST"	-- Proposition A-46, \$3,300,000 Sanitary Sewerage Plant and System Bonds	- 5020 votes
"FOR"	-- Proposition B-46, \$1,100,000 Storm Sewers and Drains Bonds	- 4323 votes
"AGAINST"	-- Proposition B-46, \$1,100,000 Storm Sewers and Drains Bonds	- 5249 votes


3. And it appearing to the Board of Commissioners that said propositions to issue bonds of the City were submitted and that the special election was held and was conducted as required by the Statutes of the State of Texas and the Charter and Ordinances of the City of San Antonio; and, that at said special election there was cast on each proposition submitting a proposition to borrow money on the credit of the City of San Antonio and to issue bonds for permanent public improvements, the aggregate number of votes marked "FOR" and the aggregate number of votes marked "AGAINST", all as shown by the report and canvass of said returns by the Board of Commissioners, and said returns having been found to be correct in all respects, it is declared that Proposition A-46 to issue \$3,300,000.00 Sanitary Sewerage Plant and System Bonds was not adopted by a majority vote, and that Proposition B-46 to issue \$1,100,000.00 Storm Sewers and Drains Bonds was not adopted by a majority vote, of the qualified voters at said election.




