

AN ORDINANCE

MAKING A CONTRACT WITH BEXAR COUNTY
FOR THE RENT OF VOTING MACHINES.

* * *

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That this ordinance makes and manifests a contract between the City of San Antonio and Bexar County, for the rental of voting machines under the provisions of the Statutes of the State of Texas with reference thereto, in words and figures as follows:-


2. That the County of Bexar leases to the City of San Antonio and the City of San Antonio hires from the County of Bexar, such a number of voting machines as may be required to hold the City Election on the 8th of May, A.D. 1945, at the rate of \$30.00 per machine net to the City, and said rental charge of \$30.00 per machine includes the drayage of each such voting machine so used, to each polling place within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio and the return to the Court House of each such voting machine.

3. The City of San Antonio shall cause the ballots to be prepared and the preparation of the machines to be used in the polling places, as well as the servicing of said machines on said election day, at the expense of the City of San Antonio.


4. That \$4,560.00 is appropriated out of the 1944 General Fund - Election Department, to pay the rent of 152 machines as estimated as the requirements for said election.

5. PASSED AND APPROVED this 17th day of March, A.D. 1945.



VOTING MACHINES.

ORDER AUTHORIZING COUNTY JUDGE TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO FOR RENTAL OF MACHINES, ETC.

A motion was presented by County Commissioner Sam C. Bennett, duly seconded by County Commissioner R.W. Stappenbeck, Sr., and motion voted as follows: Commissioners Anderson, Bennett, Uhr and Stappenbeck voting "Aye":

It is ordered by the Court that Charles W. Anderson, County Judge of Bexar County, be, and he is hereby, authorized to enter into a contract with the Mayor of the City of San Antonio for the rental of such number of voting machines as may be required to hold a city election on May 8th, 1945 at the rate of thirty dollars (\$30.00) per machine net to said city; said rental charge contract is to contain a provision that said sum of \$30.00 per machine includes the drayage for each such voting machine so used to each polling place within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio and the return to the Courthouse of each such voting machine; and in addition to the rental above provided for, the City of San Antonio shall cause to be prepared the ballots and the preparation of the machines to be used in the polling places, as well as the servicing of said machines on said election day, all at the expense of said City of San Antonio.
