RESOLUTION

APPROVING TEXAS RELIEF COMMISSION PROJECT FOR HOUSE TO HOUSE SURVEY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF
SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, IN PREVENTION OF RABIES, MOSQUITO BREEDING PLACES AND GENERAL INSANITARY
CONDITIONS AFFECTING THE HEALTH OF THE COMMUNITY, AND AMENDING RESOLUTION ADOPTED APRIL 12, 1934.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That the resolution adopted by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, on the 12th day of April, A. D. 1934, entitled "A RESOLUTION APPROVING CIVIL WORKS PROJECT 597-C-1 FOR HOUSE TO HOUSE SURVEY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, IN PREVENTION OF RABIES, MOSQUITO BREEDING PLACES AND GENERAL INSANITARY CONDITIONS AFFECTING THE HEALTH OF THE COMMUNITY", of record in Vol. M, page 147 of the Minutes of the Proceedings of the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, be amended so as to hereafter read as follows:-

2. "THAT Texas Relief Commission Project for House to House Survey within the City Limits of San Antonio, Texas, object prevention of Rabies, Mosquito Breeding Places and General Insanitary Conditions affecting the Health of the Community, be and the same is hereby approved, and that the City of San Antonio will contribute office space, desks, telephone, light, fuel, trucks, etc., of thereasonable value of \$1382.80, which will br available upon demand of the Texas Relief Commission."
