AN ORDINANCE (721) *MQ-322*

ACCEPTING THE ATTACHED PROPOSAL OF ORSINGER MOTOR CO., TO FURNISH THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, FIRE DEPARTMENT, WITH TWO HUDSON 1940 MODEL 40-T COUPE AUTOMOBILES AS SPECIFIED IN THIS ORDINANCE BELOW:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the attached proposal of Orsinger Motor Co., be, and is hereby accepted to furnish the City of San Antonio, Fire Department, with Two Hudson 1940 Model 40-T Coupe Automobiles, equipped with Philco #821 P Radio with Antenna and Delco Remy 934F Police Generator and special Upholstering job, color tan, as per sample for a net total sum of \$1,396.56 and this amount being hereby appropriated out of the 1939 General Fund, Fire Department, in payment of same.

AN ORDINANCE (722) *-323*

FIXING THE STATUS AND COMPENSATION OF CAPTAIN J.W. PATTERSON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That from and after October 1st, 1939, Senior Captain J.W. Patterson, of the San Antonio Fire Department, shall receive a monthly salary of \$200.00 per month, of which the City of San Antonio shall pay the sum of \$50.00 per month, through the San An-

tonio Board of Education, and the balance of same, to-wit: \$150.00 per month, shall be received from the Texas State Board for Vocational Education and the San Antonio Independent School District of the City of San Antonio, said Senior Captain Patterson being enrolled as a teacher and instructor of vocational education, to-wit: Science of Fire Fighting and Prevention; there is hereby appropriated from the General Fund Fire Department Account, the sum of \$600.00 to apply on said salary for one year, beginning October 1, 1939, which appropriation shall be paid at the rate of \$50.00 monthly to said Board of Education for the account of said Senior Captain Patterson.

2. Captain Patterson shall perform the duties of teacher and instructor of Science of Fire Fighting and Prevention in the training schools of said Fire Department for said period.

3. Captain Patterson shall retain his membership, commission and present rank in said Fire Department, and his status shall be otherwise unchanged.
