

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO,
SITTING AS A COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE, HELD AT 11:30 O'CLOCK,
A. M., ON TUESDAY, MARCH 19th, 1946.

PRESENT: Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson; Mayor Mauermann presiding.

The Mayor and Commissioners met as a Committee of the Whole, at the call of the Mayor, in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, on Tuesday, March 19th, 1946, immediately after the Recessed Council Meeting of that date, and considered and acted upon the following:

Following a general discussion on the matter of connecting sewers in the Terrell Heights and Bel Meade Subdivisions to the City sewer system, Commissioner Steffler moved as follows:

That the City agree to reimburse W.K. Ewing Co., owner of the Terrell Heights Subdivision, in a sum not to exceed \$10,000, provided the owner constructs the necessary extension to connect with Terrell Heights Subdivision of the City sewer system/and furnishes the right-of-way; the plans to be approved by the City Engineer; and payment to be made in the fiscal year 1946. After a second by Commissioner Hein, the motion was carried by roll call vote, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson.

Commissioner Steffler also moved: That the City agree to reimburse Steves Bros., Inc., and Ed Steves & Sons, owners of Bel Meade Addition, in a sum not to exceed \$5,000, provided the owners construct the necessary extension of the City sewer system to connect with Bel Meade Addition and furnish the right-of-way; the plans to be approved by the City Engineer; and payment to be made in the fiscal year 1946. After a second by Commissioner Hein, the motion was carried by roll call vote, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson.
