89-20 CANVASS OF VOTES ON MAY 4, 1989 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Mayor Cisneros noted that the City Council and selected City staff members now would undertake the official canvass of the vote on the May 4, 1989 Municipal Election.

The official vote-canvass then took place.

At the conclusion of the official canvass of the vote, Mayor Cisneros stated that the canvass found no significant changes to be made to the unofficial election returns, and he declared the vote canvass on the election to be complete.

The City Clerk then read the vote totals in each of the City Council races in the May 4, 1989 Municipal Election, and spoke to minor corrections to be made in the write-in vote category in Districts 2 and 9.

Mr. Hasslocher made a motion to approve the proposed Ordinance. Mr. Webb seconded the motion.

Mayor Cisneros congratulated each of the winning candidates and wished them well.

After consideration, the motion, carrying with it the passage of the Ordinance, prevailed by the following vote: AYES: Berriozabal, Webb, Dutmer, Thompson, Vera, Labatt, Hasslocher, Cisneros; NAYS: None; ABSENT: Wing, Martinez, Wolff.

Mayor Cisneros then signed and distributed to the winning candidates their individual Certificates of Election, and spoke of the key accomplishments of each returning City Council member. He then presented the Certificate of Election to Mayor-elect Lila Cockrell, who received individual congratulations from City Council members, as well.

Mayor-elect Cockrell then paid her respects to the record of achievement reached by Mayor Cisneros during his eight years of service to the City of San Antonio.

City Clerk Norma S. Rodriguez reminded each of the winning candidates that they must officially be sworn into office within 10 days of the election date.

Mr. Thompson spoke of the productive 'mix' of talents among the City Council members, working together.
