

AN ORDINANCE **55125**

AMENDING CHAPTER 10 OF THE CITY CODE
PERTAINING TO BARBED WIRE FENCES.

* * * *

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Chapter 10, Section 10-11 (Same -- Barbed wire fences) Sub-section (a) of the City Code of the City of San Antonio is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 10-11. Same - Barbed wire fences.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to erect or cause to be erected on any street or property within the city, any fence composed either wholly or in part of barbed wire, unless the use of such barbed wire is restricted to the placing of not more than three (3) strands thereof at the top of any fence over six (6) feet in height, provided such strand or strands slant away from the street or adjoining property and toward the property such fence may bound. Should the uppermost strand of barbed wire be not more than eighteen (18) inches higher than the top of the fence, and not over ten (10) feet from ground level, the strands of barbed wire shall not be considered in determining fence height restrictions."

Construction of a fence in violation of the above provision shall be punished, upon conviction, by a fine not in excess of \$200.00, and each day during which an owner maintains or allows a fence to remain in violation hereof shall constitute a separate offense, also punishable by a fine not in excess of \$200.00.

This ordinance amends Chapter 10, Article 1, Section 10-11 of the City Code, titled Barbed Wire Fences.

Background Information

This amendment restricts the use of barbed wire to the placing of not more than three (3) strands at the top of any fence over six (6) feet in height, provided such strand or strands slant away from the street or adjoining property and toward the property such fence may bound.

This amendment is necessary in order to enforce the barbed wire provision when dealing with fences, with barbed wire, separating two private properties.




It is requested that the City Attorney prepare an ordinance amending Chapter 10, Article 1, Section 10-11 of the City Code to read as follows:

Section 10-11. Same - Barbed wire fences.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to erect or cause to be erected on any street or property within the city, any fence composed either wholly or in part of barbed wire, unless the use of such barbed wire is restricted to the placing of not more than three (3) strands thereof at the top of any fence over six (6) feet in height, provided such strand or strands slant away from the street or adjoining property and toward the property such fence may bound. Should the uppermost strand of barbed wire be not more than eighteen (18) inches higher than the top of the fence, and not over ten (10) feet from ground level, the strands of barbed wire shall not be considered in determining fence height restrictions.

This amendment is necessary in order to enforce the barbed wire provision when dealing with fences with barbed wire separating two private properties, and I recommend approval.

It is requested that it be placed on the City Council "A" Session agenda of March 18, 1982.
