

AN ORDINANCE 2013-05-09-0324

**AUTHORIZING A TWO-YEAR EXTENSION OF THE
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR
OPERATION & MAINTENANCE OF GROWDON ROAD
VEHICLE STORAGE FACILITY WITH UNITED ROAD
TOWING, INC.**

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio (City) and United Road Towing, Inc. (Contractor) entered into the Professional Services Agreement for Operation & Maintenance of Growden Road Vehicle Storage Facility on March 17, 2008, (Contract); and

WHEREAS, the initial term of said Contract is March 17, 2008, to May 17, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2 of said Contract provides that the parties may extend its term for two years, until May 17, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Contractor has satisfactorily provided vehicle storage services at the Growdon Road Vehicle Storage Facility, and

WHEREAS, City and Contractor wish to amend the aforementioned Contract to provide for a two-year extension; and

WHEREAS, all other terms and conditions contained in the Contract shall remain in full force and effect; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to execute the Second Amendment to Professional Services Agreement for Operation & Maintenance of Growdon Road Vehicle Storage Facility with United Road Towing, Inc. (Second Amendment), which is attached hereto as **Exhibit I**, to provide for a two-year extension of the Contract. The terms of the Second Amendment are hereby approved. Should said Second Amendment not be executed within ninety days of the effective date of this Ordinance, further City Council authorization shall be required

SECTION 2. Funds generated by this ordinance will be deposited into Fund 11001000, Internal Order 217000000045, and General Ledger 4404237.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.



**SECOND AMENDMENT TO
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT
FOR
OPERATION & MAINTENANCE OF GROWDEN ROAD
VEHICLE STORAGE FACILITY**

This Second Amendment to Professional Services Agreement for Operation & Maintenance of Growden Road Vehicle Storage Facility (Amendment) is entered into by and between the City of San Antonio (City) and United Road Towing, Inc. (Contractor).

WHEREAS, City and Contractor entered into the Professional Services Agreement for Operation & Maintenance of Growden Road Vehicle Storage Facility on March 17, 2008, (Contract); and

WHEREAS, the initial term of said Contract is March 17, 2008, to May 17, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2 of said Contract provides that the parties may extend its term for two years, until May 17, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the aforementioned Contract to provide for a two-year extension; **NOW THEREFORE:**

THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Contractor and City hereby agree to the addition of Section 2.3 to the Contract. Said section shall provide as follows:

- 2.3 In accordance with Section 2.2 and by agreement of the parties hereto, this Contract is extended for a period of two years, until May 17, 2015.

SECTION 2. All provisions of the Contract not addressed by this second amendment shall remain in full force and effect
