SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO,
HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER OF THE CITY HALL, AT TEN O'CLOCK,
A.M., ON SATURDAY, THE EIGHTH DAY OF MARCH, A.D. 1947.

The Clerk read the call, as follows:

March 7th, 1947

To the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio:-

Gentlemen:

By virtue of the authority vested in me by the Charter of the City of San Antonio, I hereby call you in Special Session, to be held at 10:00 o'clock, A.M., on Saturday, March 8th, 1947, in the Council Chamber of the City Hall of San Antonio, Texas, to consider and act upon the following:

"AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE COMMISSIONER OF STREETS AND PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS WITH CIVIL AERONAUTICS AUTHORITY AND OTHERS, FOR CONSTRUCTION OF SANITARY SEWER LINE IN AREA LYING BETWEEN THE CITIES OF OLMOS PARK AND ALAMO HEIGHTS AND THE SAN ANTONIO MUNICIPAL AIRPORT";

"AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO CONDEMN CERTAIN PROPERTY OF HANGAR SIX, INC., FOR A MUNICIPAL AIRPORT AND OTHER PUBLIC PURPOSES";

"AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO TO EXECUTE 'APPLICATION BY LESSOR' FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE WAR ASSETS ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT";

Commissioner P. L. Anderson called up for a vote an Ordinance introduced in the Council meeting of August 9, 1945, and published in the Commercial Recorder of August 10, 1945, which ordinance was passed and approved by the following vote on roll call, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Steffler and Anderson:

AN ORDINANCE (4754)

PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN ADDITIONAL TERRITORY ADJACENT TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY (No. 3 - SOUTH)

On recommendation of Commissioner P. L. Anderson, seconded by Commissioner Hein and duly carried by roll call vote, the following petitions were granted:

Oil & Refining Company
The Humble/to install two 1000 gallon underground storage tanks at 1027 East Commerce Street, and one 1000 gallon underground storage tank at 917 Broadway.

The Magnolia Petroleum Company to install one 550 gallon storage tank and one Used Electric Computing Pump at 126 Camp Street, for Southern Delivery Service; two 1000 gallon underground storage tanks and two electric computing pumps at 600 Simpson Street for Lone Star Brewing Company; and two electric computing pumps at 701 South Flores and Arsenal, for Connally Brothers.

Sinclair Refining Company to replace one 10 gallon visible gasoline pump with one electric computer pump at 2018 Roosevelt Avenue;

Jack Neal, Inc. to install one 550 gallon underground storage gasoline tank at 1402 South Presa, DuBose Service Station; and to replace one 1000 gallon underground storage gasoline tank at 3901 South Presa, Joe Lynch Service Station.


