No. AN ORDINANCE MK-804
 TO ABOLISH AND CLOSE A PART OF PIEDMONT AVENUE ON APPLICATION OF THE SAN ANTONIO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the part of Piedmont Avenue shown on the plats of the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, out of City Block A-29, bounded on the North by Astor Street, on the East by property of the San Antonio Independent School District, on the South by Fair Avenue, and on the West by property of the San Antonio Independent School District, be and the same is hereby abolished, closed and abandoned by the City of San Antonio as a public street, insofar as the rights of the City of San Antonio are affected; upon the condition that the San Antonio Independent School District convey or cause to be conveyed to the City of San Antonio a street to extend Fair Avenue from its present terminus at the East line of Piedmont Avenue extended, to the East line of Palmetto Avenue.

2. This Ordinance is passed and approved as a matter of public necessity and convenience, it being for the best interest of the inhabitants of the City of San Antonio to close Piedmont Avenue and open Fair Avenue to establish a site for a public school so that the safety of the children and the convenience of the public may be promoted.

3. PASSED AND APPROVED, this 21st day of September, A. D. 1931.




