No. 520 AN ORDINANCE *- 1194*

No. 521 AN ORDINANCE *- 1195*

Appropriating \$30,000.00 to pay February Merchants Bills.
BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is hereby appropriated out of 1920 General Fund to pay duly approved merchants bills for the month of February, 1921 per itemized invoices on file in office of the City Auditor.


A hearing was given to the owners of property abutting on Cypress Street between Brooklyn Avenue and McCullough Avenue.


A hearing was given to the owners of property abutting on Brooklyn Avenue from Oakland Street to Cypress Street.
