

AN ORDINANCE

**CANVASSING ELECTION RETURNS AND DECLARING
THE RESULTS OF THE MAY 6, 2000 SPECIAL ELECTION**

* * * * *

WHEREAS, the City Council (the "City Council") of the City of San Antonio, Texas (the "City") desired to provide for the planning, acquisition, establishment, development, construction or renovation of various "venue projects" (collectively, the "Venue Projects") as authorized by, and defined in, Chapter 334, as amended, Texas Local Government Code ("Chapter 334" or the "Act"), which are further described below; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 334.042(d), Texas Local Government Code, if one or more of such Venue Projects was approved by the voters, the City may use money received from the sales and use tax approved by the voters in connection with such approved Venue Projects to reimburse or pay the costs of planning, acquiring, establishing, developing, constructing, or renovating such approved Venue Projects, pay the principal of, interest on, and other costs relating to bonds or other obligations issued by the City to finance a Venue Project, and pay the costs of operating or maintaining one or more approved Venue Projects; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Section 334.021, Texas Local Government Code, the City Council duly adopted Resolution No. 2000-04-07, on January 27, 2000, which was later amended by Ordinance No. 91262 (An Ordinance Ordering a Special Election, which Ordinance was passed and approved by the City Council on February 1, 2000), which Resolution No. 2000-04-07, as amended by Ordinance No. 91262 is hereinafter referred to as the "Venue Projects Resolution," designating each of the projects identified therein as a "Venue Project" and designating the method of financing of each such Venue Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council was authorized by Section 334.024, Texas Local Government Code to order an election on the question of approving and implementing the Venue Projects Resolution and approving each Venue Project and the method of financing each Venue Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Section 334.021, Texas Local Government Code, the City, before calling such election did send a copy of the Venue Projects Resolution to the State Comptroller, who did (1) perform an analysis to determine if approval and implementation of the Venue Projects Resolution will have a significant negative fiscal impact on state revenue, and (2) provide the City with written notice of the results of the analysis that implementation of the Venue Projects Resolution will not have a significant negative impact on state revenue; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 334.024 of the Act, as amended, the City Council ordered an election to be held in the City on Saturday, May 6, 2000, on the question of approving the Venue Projects and implementing the Venue Projects Resolution which designates, and provides for the

planning, acquisition, establishment, development, construction, or renovation of, and the method of financing for, the following four "venue projects":

- (1) THE SAN ANTONIO RIVER VENUE PROJECT,
- (2) THE KELLY AIR FORCE BASE VENUE PROJECT,
- (3) THE PARKS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT, AND
- (4) THE BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT; and

WHEREAS, the City did hold such election on Saturday, May 6, 2000, on the question of approving and implementing the Venue Projects Resolution and approving the Venue Projects as described in the PROPOSITIONS hereinafter stated; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has investigated all matters pertaining to said election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding and making returns of said election; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held said election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby canvasses the returns of this election, at which there was submitted to all resident, qualified electors of the City for their action thereupon, the following propositions:

SAN ANTONIO RIVER VENUE PROJECT PROPOSITION

PROPOSITION NO. 1

AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO TO PROVIDE FOR THE PLANNING, ACQUISITION, ESTABLISHMENT, DEVELOPMENT, CONSTRUCTION, OR RENOVATION OF THE "**SAN ANTONIO RIVER VENUE PROJECT**", AND TO IMPOSE A SALES AND USE TAX (FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED TEN YEARS FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUCH TAX) AT THE MAXIMUM RATE NOT TO EXCEED ONE-EIGHTH OF ONE PERCENT (1/8%) (A PORTION OF WHICH TAX SHALL BE SHARED WITH AND USED FOR THE "**KELLY AIR FORCE BASE VENUE PROJECT,**" THE "**PARKS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT,**" AND THE "**BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT**" IF ONE OR MORE OF SUCH VENUE PROJECTS ARE ALSO APPROVED BY THE VOTERS) FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING (IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,000,000, INCLUDING COSTS OF ISSUANCE AND INTEREST ON BONDS, ANY) THE "**SAN ANTONIO RIVER VENUE PROJECT.**"

PROPOSITION NO. 2

AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO TO PROVIDE FOR THE PLANNING, ACQUISITION, ESTABLISHMENT, DEVELOPMENT, CONSTRUCTION, OR RENOVATION OF THE "***KELLY AIR FORCE BASE VENUE PROJECT***" WHICH INCLUDES THE LAND, BUILDINGS, EQUIPMENT, FACILITIES, TARGETED INFRASTRUCTURE AND IMPROVEMENTS FOUND BY THE CITY TO BE REQUIRED OR SUITABLE FOR THE PROMOTION OF DEVELOPMENT OR REDEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION, INCLUDING COSTS OF ADMINISTRATION AND OPERATION, OF KELLY AIR FORCE BASE (WHICH IS BEING CLOSED OR REALIGNED PURSUANT TO APPLICABLE FEDERAL LAW), AND FACILITIES WHICH ARE RELATED THERETO, AND RELATED INFRASTRUCTURE, AND TO IMPOSE A SALES AND USE TAX (FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED TEN YEARS FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUCH TAX) AT THE MAXIMUM RATE NOT TO EXCEED ONE-EIGHTH OF ONE PERCENT (1/8%) (A PORTION OF WHICH TAX SHALL BE SHARED WITH AND USED FOR THE "***SAN ANTONIO RIVER VENUE PROJECT***," THE "***PARKS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT***," AND THE "***BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT***" IF ONE OR MORE OF SUCH VENUE PROJECTS ARE ALSO APPROVED BY THE VOTERS) FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING (IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000,000, INCLUDING COSTS OF ISSUANCE AND INTEREST ON BONDS, IF ANY THE "***KELLY AIR FORCE BASE VENUE PROJECT***."

PARKS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT PROPOSITION

PROPOSITION NO. 3

AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO TO PROVIDE FOR THE PLANNING, ACQUISITION, ESTABLISHMENT, DEVELOPMENT, CONSTRUCTION, OR RENOVATION OF THE "***PARKS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT***" WHICH INCLUDES THE ACQUISITION OF OPEN SPACE OVER THE EDWARDS AQUIFER RECHARGE ZONE (THE "OPEN SPACE PARKS") AND LINEAR PARKS WITHIN THE CITY ALONG LEON CREEK AND SALADO CREEK (THE "LINEAR PARKS") AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS OR ADDITIONS TO SUCH OPEN SPACE PARKS AND LINEAR PARKS, AND TO IMPOSE A SALES AND USE TAX (FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED TEN YEARS FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUCH TAX) AT THE MAXIMUM RATE NOT TO EXCEED ONE-EIGHTH OF ONE PERCENT (1/8%) (A PORTION OF WHICH TAX SHALL BE SHARED WITH AND USED FOR THE "***SAN ANTONIO RIVER VENUE PROJECT***," THE "***KELLY AIR FORCE BASE VENUE PROJECT***," AND THE

"BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT" IF SUCH VENUE PROJECTS ARE ALSO APPROVED BY THE VOTERS) FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING (IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$65,000,000, INCLUDING COSTS OF ISSUANCE AND INTEREST ON BONDS, IF ANY) THE "PARKS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT."

BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT PROPOSITION

PROPOSITION NO. 4

AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO TO PROVIDE FOR THE PLANNING, ACQUISITION, ESTABLISHMENT, DEVELOPMENT, CONSTRUCTION, OR RENOVATION OF THE *"BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT"* WHICH INCLUDES (I) JOB TRAINING REQUIRED OR SUITABLE FOR THE PROMOTION OF DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION OF BUSINESS ENTERPRISES, AND (II) THE LAND, BUILDINGS, EQUIPMENT, FACILITIES, TARGETED INFRASTRUCTURE AND IMPROVEMENTS FOUND BY THE CITY TO (a) BE REQUIRED OR SUITABLE FOR THE PROMOTION OF DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION OF MANUFACTURING AND INDUSTRIAL FACILITIES; OR (b) PROMOTE OR DEVELOP NEW OR EXPANDED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES, INCLUDING PROJECTS TO PROVIDE PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITIES, STREETS AND ROADS, DRAINAGE AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS, DEMOLITION OF EXISTING STRUCTURES, GENERAL MUNICIPALLY OWNED IMPROVEMENTS, AS WELL AS ANY IMPROVEMENTS OR FACILITIES THAT ARE RELATED TO ANY OF THOSE PROJECTS; AND TO IMPOSE A SALES AND USE TAX (FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED TEN YEARS FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUCH TAX) AT THE MAXIMUM RATE NOT TO EXCEED ONE-EIGHTH OF ONE PERCENT (1/8%) (A PORTION OF WHICH TAX SHALL BE SHARED WITH AND USED FOR THE *"SAN ANTONIO RIVER VENUE PROJECT,"* THE *"KELLY AIR FORCE BASE VENUE PROJECT,"* AND THE *"PARKS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT"* IF SUCH VENUE PROJECTS ARE ALSO APPROVED BY THE VOTERS)

FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING (IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED AN AGGREGATE OF \$30,000,000 [INCLUDING COSTS OF ISSUANCE AND INTEREST ON BONDS, IF ANY], TO BE ALLOCATED APPROXIMATELY EQUALLY AMONG THE TEN COUNCIL DISTRICTS FOR IMPROVEMENTS DESCRIBED ABOVE, WITH ALL OTHER SALES AND USE TAX REVENUES [EXCLUDING SUCH REVENUES WHICH WOULD HAVE BEEN ALLOCATED TO FINANCE ANY OTHER VENUE PROJECT THAT IS NOT APPROVED BY THE VOTERS] AND SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO FINANCE OTHER IMPROVEMENTS DESCRIBED ABOVE) THE *"BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT."*

WHEREAS, the City Council has diligently inquired into the poll lists and the official election returns which were duly and lawfully made to this City Council by the judges and clerks holding and conducting such election and which show separately the votes cast in the election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds and determines that the canvassing of the election returns has been conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code, the City's Home Rule Charter (the "Charter"), and applicable law; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS. The City Council officially finds and determines that said election was duly ordered; proper notice of said election was duly given; proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election; said election was duly held; the City has complied with the Federal Voting Rights Act and the Texas Election Code; due returns of the result of said election have been made and delivered; and the City Council has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the Ordinance calling the election.

SECTION 2. VOTES CAST ON EACH PROPOSITION. The City Council officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at said election on the submitted PROPOSITIONS by the resident, qualified electors of the City who voted at the election:

FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING (IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED AN AGGREGATE OF \$30,000,000 [INCLUDING COSTS OF ISSUANCE AND INTEREST ON BONDS, IF ANY], TO BE ALLOCATED APPROXIMATELY EQUALLY AMONG THE TEN COUNCIL DISTRICTS FOR IMPROVEMENTS DESCRIBED ABOVE, WITH ALL OTHER SALES AND USE TAX REVENUES [EXCLUDING SUCH REVENUES WHICH WOULD HAVE BEEN ALLOCATED TO FINANCE ANY OTHER VENUE PROJECT THAT IS NOT APPROVED BY THE VOTERS] AND SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO FINANCE OTHER IMPROVEMENTS DESCRIBED ABOVE) THE

SECTION 3. DECLARATION OF RESULTS. The City Council officially finds, determines, and declares the result of said election to be that the **PROPOSITION NUMBER 3 - PARKS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT PROPOSITION** - so submitted was approved by 7,085 votes (or 53.9% of the votes cast) and has received a favorable majority vote in all respects and has carried, and that Proposition Numbers 1, 2, and 4 were not approved and have not carried.

SECTION 4. AUTHORITY FOR IMPLEMENTING THE VENUE PROJECTS RESOLUTION AND IMPOSING THE SALES AND USE TAX; SUBSEQUENT ADOPTION OF SALES TAX LEVY ORDINANCE. The City Council hereby finds that pursuant to such election, the voters of the City (i) have, as a result of such election, authorized the City Council to implement the Venue Projects Resolution, as amended, with respect only to **PROPOSITION NUMBER 3 - PARKS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT PROPOSITION**, and (ii) have further, as a result of such election, authorized the City Council to impose, levy, assess, and collect the aforesaid sales and use tax, as provided by the Act, up to an amount not to exceed the \$65 million limit contained in **PROPOSITION NUMBER 3 - PARKS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT PROPOSITION** - as voted and as provided by law, for the purpose of financing the said **PROPOSITION NUMBER 3 - PARKS DEVELOPMENT AND EXPANSION VENUE PROJECT**. The City Council shall hereafter adopt, by separate and subsequent action, an ordinance (the "Sales Tax Levy Ordinance") adopting, imposing, and levying the aforesaid sales and use tax at the maximum rate not to exceed one-eighth of one percent (1/8%) as approved by the voters of the City.

SECTION 5. AUTHORITY TO SEND NOTICE OF RESULTS OF ELECTION TO THE STATE COMPTROLLER. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to send to State Comptroller by United States certified or registered mail a certified copy of this Ordinance, along with a map of the City clearly showing the boundaries of the City, and, upon its adoption hereafter, a certified copy of the Sales Tax Levy Ordinance, as required by Chapter 334 of the Act, and Section 321.405, Texas Tax Code.

SECTION 6. ORDINANCE TO CONTROL. All ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matters ordained herein.

SECTION 7. INCORPORATION OF RECITALS. The Issuer hereby finds that the statements set forth in the recitals of this Ordinance are true and correct, and the Issuer hereby incorporates such recitals as a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any circumstance shall be held to be invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance and the application thereof to other circumstances shall nevertheless be valid, and this governing body hereby declares that this Ordinance would have been enacted without such invalid provision.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final passage as provided by the provisions of the City Charter.




