AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING DEED OF C. A. R. CAMPBELL AND A. C. PANCOAST, THURMAN BARRETT AND Z. D. BONNER, AND DEDICATION FROM BEXAR COUNTY FOR ADDITIONAL LAND FOR THE EXTENSION OF MAIN AVENUE SOUTH FROM DOLOROSA STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That the City of San Antonio accepts the order dedicating certain property between Dolorosa Street and Nueva Street as a public highway for the extension and widening of Main Avenue South, promulgated at a meeting of the County Commissioners of the County of Bexar on the 7th day of November, A. D. 1929; and agrees to construct Main Avenue South into a sixty four street through New City Block One Hundred (100), on the property heretofore conveyed and here conveyed by the persons mentioned in this ordinance.
2. The conveyance of the realty by the County shall be full accord and satisfaction of the cost of the opening and extension, the curbing and the pavement, and no assessment shall be made against the remaining property of the County on account of the instant improvements.
3. That the City of San Antonio accepts the deed of C. A. R. Campbell for certain property between Dolorosa Street and Nueva Street as a public highway for the extension and widening of Main Avenue South, signed on the 5th day of December, A. D. 1929.
4. The conveyance of the realty by C. A. R. Campbell shall be full accord and satisfaction for any assessment for street opening and widening, paving, sidewalks, curbs and gutters, and no assessment shall be made against the remaining property of C. A. R. Campbell for the instant improvements.
5. That the City of San Antonio accepts the deed of A. C. Pancoast, Thurman Barrett and Z. D. Bonner for certain property between Dolorosa Street and Nueva Street as a public high-

way for the extension and widening of Main Avenue South, signed on the 5th day of November, A. D. 1929.

6. The conveyance of the realty by A. C. Pancoast, Thurman Barrett and Z. D. Bonner shall be full accord and satisfaction for any assessment for street opening and widening, paving, curbs and gutters, and no assessment shall be made against the remaining property of A. C. Pancoast, Thurman Barrett and Z. D. Bonner for the instant improvements.

7. The City Clerk is directed to file and record the conveyances hereinabove described, and the City Engineer and the City Tax Assessor are hereby directed to change their records to conform with the new street locations.
