

AN ORDINANCE      **2011-03-31-0227**

**AUTHORIZING A FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$141,575.35, OF WHICH \$113,260.28 WILL BE REIMBURSED BY THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, AND AMENDING A FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO REIMBURSE THE CITY FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF CONCRETE ROAD CROSSING PANELS AND ASSOCIATED ENGINEERING SERVICES, FOR THE MISSION TRAILS PACKAGE IV AND V PROJECT, A CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION FUNDED PROJECT, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICTS 1, 3, AND 5**

**WHEREAS**, Mission Trails (Package IV) scope reconstructs Mission Road over an existing Union Pacific Railroad crossing to widen the street and extend Union Pacific Railroad concrete panels to provide adequate space for the proposed street improvements and provide vehicles a smooth ride over the tracks; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2007-01-18-0081 approved an Advance Funding Agreement with Texas Department of Transportation and provided for the reconstruction of Mission Road from Mitchell Road to Roosevelt Avenue, curbs, sidewalks, five-foot bike lanes and drainage improvements to increase drainage capacity, and Package V provided signage along the Mission Trails system from the Alamo to Mission Espada; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance authorizes the execution of a Funding Agreement with **Union Pacific Railroad** in the amount not to exceed \$141,575.35 of which the Texas Department of Transportation will reimburse the City an amount of \$113,260.28 as part of the Local Agency Management process and \$28,315.07 will be paid from the Project Contingency; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance also amends a Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation to reimburse the City for reconstruction of concrete road crossings panels and associated engineering services for the Mission Trails Package IV and V Project; and

**WHEREAS**, approval of this Ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to collaborate with other governmental agencies in supporting the City's commitment of maintaining and improving existing infrastructure; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to execute a Funding Agreement with **Union Pacific Railroad** in the total amount not to exceed \$141,575.35 for the reconstruction of concrete road crossings panels and associated engineering services for the Mission Trails Package IV and V Project.

**SECTION 2.** The following financial adjustments are hereby authorized to effect this Ordinance:

- a) Funds are authorized to be received from the TXDOT to SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 23-00789, Mission Trails Package 4, shall be revised by increasing WBS element 23-00789-90-02, entitled TXDOT Contribution, SAP GL Account 4502280 – Contribution from other Agencies, by the amount of \$113,260.28.
- b) The amount of \$113,260.28 is appropriated in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 23-00789, Mission Trails Package 4, SAP WBS Element 23-00789-05-02-01-02, entitled Construction-TXDOT, SAP GL Account 5201140.
- c) Payment in the amount not to exceed \$141,575.35 in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 23-00789, Mission Trails Package 4, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to **Union Pacific Railroad**.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.




