

AN ORDINANCE OH-34

AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE CREATING SAN JOSE BURIAL PARK, REGULATING THE SALE OF LOTS THEREIN, AND ITS OPERATION".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That Paragraphs 7 and 7-a of "An Ordinance amending an ordinance creating San Jose Burial Park, regulating sale of lots therein, and its operation", passed and approved on the 15th day of December, A. D. 1930, be and the same are hereby amended to read as follows:-

2. Paragraph 7. Fifty (50%) per cent of the income from the sale of lots, parts of lots and/or single graves, of the San Jose Burial Park shall be placed in the Permanent Maintenance Fund of the San Jose Burial Park. This Fund herein created shall be placed out at interest in bonds of the City of San Antonio, or any improvement district thereof, Bexar County, the State of Texas, or the United States of America, when same shall have accrued to a sum which would make practicable so doing; and the interest only thereon shall be placed in the Cemetery Fund for current operation;

3. Paragraph 7-a. And Fifty (50%) per cent of the income from the sale of lots, parts of lots and/or from the sale of single graves, and all income from digging graves, placing foundations for monuments, special care of lots or from other work done in the course of the operation of the Cemetery, shall be placed in the San Jose Burial Park Operating Fund, to be used for the current operation of the Cemetery, and the construction work therein.

4. The importance of this legislation for the order, good government and general welfare of the City of San Antonio creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the stipulation requiring an ordinance of a general character to be read at three several meetings before receiving final action thereon, is hereby otherwise ordered by a two-thirds vote of the full Board, and it is ordered that this ordinance shall go into effect and be in full force from and after its passage by the four-fifths vote of the Commissioners, as required by Section 36 of the Charter of the City of San Antonio.
