Invocation by Winston Martin, Director of Planning.

On motion of Mr. Baines, seconded by Mr. Winton, the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with.

Zoning Case No. 797 to rezone property in New City Block 11134 from "A" TEMPORARY RESIDENCE DISTRICT to "F" LOCAL RETAIL DISTRICT was next called up for hearing.

The Planning Director briefed the Council on the requested change and on the recommendation of the Planning Commission.

No one appeared to be heard; on motion of Mr. Crumrine, seconded by Mr. Friedrich, the Council approved the recommendation of the Planning Commission to rezone the property by adoption of the following ordinance.

Turner appeared in behalf of his petition for a change explaining that the property was not fitted for residential purposes and that he would be punished if required to maintain it as residential.

Mrs. Alvin Boysch, Mrs. Chas. Kalka and Mr. Joe R. Beck protested the change and filed a petition with some 50 signatures in protest. The main argument being that a church is to be erected adjoining this tract.

After discussion by many of the petitioners with the Council, Mr. Baines moved that the change petitioned be granted and the recommendation of the Planning Commission be overridden. Seconded by Friedrich, the motion carried and the following ordinance was adopted by the following vote: AYES, Friedrich, Baines, Crumrine, Winton, Kuykendall, Daniels, San Martin; NAYS, Olivares; ABSENT, Passur.
