AN ORDINANCE **63419**

DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD THE 9TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1986, ON A PROPOSITION TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO.

WHEREAS, a special municipal election was held on the 9th day of August, 1986, on a proposition to amend the Charter of the City of San Antonio, as provided by Ordinance Number 62969 (incorporated herein by reference) adopted May 29, 1986; and

WHEREAS, said election was held and the returns made all according to law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council met on August 11, 1986, to canvass the returns of said election; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council having canvassed the returns of the said special election held August 9, 1986, on the proposition to amend the Charter of the City of San Antonio, does hereby find and declare the results of this election to be as follows:

Shall the Charter of the City of San Antonio be amended by adding a Section 83a, reading as follows:

"Section 83a. LIMITATION ON BUDGET INCREASES TO BE BASED ON ANNUAL POPULATION GROWTH AND THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI). The budget referred to herein is the 'All Funds Budget, Total Net Appropriations for Total Operating/Capital Projects'. Prior to the adoption of the budget, the City Manager shall calculate the percentages of population growth in the preceding 12-month (fiscal year) for the City of San Antonio. The City Manager shall also calculate the annual percentage of inflation for the same 12-month period (fiscal year) based on the CPI, or any other valid measure of municipal inflation. In enacting the annual budget, the Council may not exceed the prior year's budget by more than the combined percentages of population and inflation as enumerated above. The Council shall not adopt a budget that exceeds the previous year's budget plus a percentage increase equal to population and inflation, for any and all purposes, unless such added budget requirements are first submitted to the qualified voters of the City of San Antonio for their approval at an election duly called and held for such purposes. This charter provision shall prevail over any

other conflicting language in this charter. If any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this amendment shall be declared unconstitutional by a valid judgment or decree of any court of valid jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences or paragraphs."

YES: 38,135 Votes      NO: 75,576 Votes

SECTION 2. The Council finds and declares that a majority of the votes cast on the proposition were cast in opposition to its adoption.

SECTION 3. The City Council, therefore, pursuant to law declares that the proposition (as set out in full in Section 1 above) has not been adopted and shall not become a part of the Charter of the City of San Antonio.
