Directing staff to begin the process to re-name Old Highway 90 to Enrique M. Barrera Memorial Pkwy


Brief Background

Mr. Barrera was born in Del Rio Texas, graduated from San Felipe High School, and received his Bachelor's degree in education from Sul Ross College in Alpine Texas. He taught at San Felipe High School and later married his wife Leticia in 1962. Shortly thereafter, they moved to San Antonio where he and his wife settled their home in the Edgewood community. In San Antonio he taught in the Edgewood School District and later served on the Edgewood School Board of Trustees from 1978 to 1990.

Mr. Barrera was a life long community advocate whose strong religious faith eventually led him to become ordained as a Deacon at San Fernando Cathedral. He retired from the Texas Department of Commerce in Austin, Texas before being appointed to the San Antonio City Council from January 13, 2000 until May 31, 2005.

Enrique was married to Leticia Cantu Galindo for 43 years when he passed away on August 31, 2007. He is survived by his wife Leticia, two children, Enrique (wife Suzanne) and Leticia (husband Gerardo), and five grandchildren, Clifford, Jessica and Lilliana Wedgeworth, and Emiliano and Eliana Barrera.



