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AN ORDINANCE 6361

AN ORDINANCE TO USE THE CITY SANITARY SEWERS BY A CONNECTION OUTSIDE OF THE CITY LIMITS, ON THE PETITION OF JACK V. BUSBEE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the petition of Jack V. Busbee, for a license to use the sanitary sewerage system of the City of San Antonio is granted hereby, subject to the following precedent conditions.

2. That the permit hereby granted is temporary and the City reserves the right to revoke same at any time, with or without notice.

3. The house plumbing and the connection with the City sewer shall be made and maintained at the cost and risk of the Licensee, in conformity with the ordinances of the City of San Antonio.

4. That this permit is intended to cover only the sewerage from the property of the Licensee, as same is now situated on said premises at Number 203 Zombrano Road, Lot 2, Block 26, Terrell Hills, and no other person shall be permitted to use the said City sanitary sewers through the connection hereby made.

5. That the future owner of the above property shall comply with all the provisions hereof, and the conditions are covenants running with the land.

6. That the use of said sewer connection shall be subject to the regulation of the City, and no use shall be made which might in any way impair the City sewer system or cause same to be obstructed or damaged in any manner whatsoever, in the opinion of the City Sewer Engineer whose judgment shall be conclusive.

7. That in consideration of the permit hereby granted and the service to be rendered, the said Licensee agrees to pay the City of San Antonio at the office of the License and Dues Collector, in San Antonio, Bexar County, as a rental charge, the schedule of fees fixed, and to be fixed by the Ordinance of the City of San Antonio, said rental commencing on the date of connection made with the City sanitary sewers; but in the event the permit hereby granted is cancelled for any reason, the pro rata amount of said rental shall be returned, less any expense incurred by the City in the premises. The City of San Antonio is given a lien on the real estate described herein to secure the payment of the sewer rental, and the City shall have the right to shut off the City water supply to the premises described herein if the Licensee fails to stop the discharge of sewerage into the City Sewerage system when the City Terminates this permit.

8. That the Inspectors of the City shall have free access to the Licensee's premises and all buildings situated thereon during the continuance of this permit and while said premises are connected with said City Sanitary Sewers, for the purpose of inspecting the condition of the plumbing and the use of said sewers.

9. The City of San Antonio shall never be liable to the Licensee for pecuniary damage for failure to take and treat the sewerage of the Licensee, and said right of action is waived as a part of the consideration of this permit.

 AN ORDINANCE 6362

AN ORDINANCE TO USE THE CITY SANITARY SEWERS BY A CONNECTION
 OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS, ON THE PETITION OF MRS. GEO.D. MCGLOIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the petition of Mrs. Geo. D. McGloin, for a license to use the sanitary sewerage system of the City of San Antonio is granted hereby, subject to the following precedent conditions.

2. That the permit hereby granted is temporary and the City reserves the right to revoke same at any time, with or without notice.

3. The house plumbing and the connection with the City sewer shall be made and maintained at the cost and risk of the Licensee, in conformity with the ordinances of the City of San Antonio.

4. That his permit is intended to cover only the sewerage from the property of the Licensee, as same is now situated on said premises at Number 206 Ridgmont Street, Lot 14, Block 26, Terrell Hills, and no other person shall be permitted to use the said City sanitary sewers through the connection hereby made.

5. That the future owner of the above property shall comply with all the provisions hereof, and the conditions are covenants running with the land.

6. That the use of said sewer connection shall be subject to the regulation of the City and no use shall be made which might in any way impair the City sewer system or cause same to be obstructed or damaged in any manner whatsoever, in the opinion of the City Sewer Engineer whose judgment shall be conclusive.

7. That in consideration of the permit hereby granted and the service to be rendered, the said Licensee agrees to pay the City of San Antonio at the office of the License and Dues Collector, in San Antonio, Bexar County, as a rental charge, the schedule of fees fixed, and to be fixed by the Ordinance of the City of San Antonio, said rental commencing on the date of connection made with the City sanitary sewers; but in the event the permit hereby granted is cancelled for any reason, the pro rata amount of said rental shall be returned, less any expense incurred by the City in the premises. The City of San Antonio is given a lien on the real estate described herein to secure the payment of the sewer rental, and the City shall have the right to shut off the City water supply to the premises described herein if the Licensee fails to stop the discharge of sewerage into the City sewerage system when the City terminates this permit.

8. That the Inspectors of the City shall have free access to the Licensee's premises and all buildings situated thereon during the continuance of this permit and while said premises are connected with said City Sanitary Sewers, for the purpose of inspecting the condition of the plumbing and the use of said sewers.

9. The City of San Antonio shall never be liable to the Licensee for pecuniary damage for failure to take and treat the sewerage of the Licensee, and said right of action is waived as a part of the consideration of this permit.

AMENDING AN ORDINANCE PASSED AND APPROVED 3 NOVEMBER, 1938, ESTABLISHING ZONING REGULATIONS AND DISTRICTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE HEIGHT, NUMBER STORIES AND SIZE OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES; PER CENT OF LOT THAT MAY BE OCCUPIED; THE SIZE OF YARDS, COURTS AND OPEN SPACES; DENSITY OF POPULATION; LOCATION AND USE OF BUILDINGS, STRUCTURES AND LAND FOR TRADE, INDUSTRY, RESIDENCE AND OTHER PURPOSES; DIVIDING THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO INTO DISTRICTS, REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, RE*CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION, REPAIR OR USE OF BUILDINGS, STRUCTURES OR LAND WITHIN SUCH DISTRICT; PROVIDING THE UNIFORM REGULATIONS FOR CLASSES OR KINDS OF BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES AND USES WITHIN THE RESTRICTED

DISTRICT; ADOPTING ZONING MAP DISCLOSING VARIOUS DISTRICTS, USE, AREAS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS AND PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO DISTRICTS AND AREAS; PROVIDING FOR A BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT AND REFINING THE POWERS WHEREOF; TO RE-ZONE PORTION OF NORTH NEW BRAUNFELS AVENUE, PROPOSITION C; TO RE-ZONE PORTION OF BLANCO ROAD, PROPOSITION D; AND TO RE-ZONE PORTION OF WEST OLMOS DRIVE, PROPOSITION E. ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS ORDINANCE OR THE OWNER OF ANY BUILDING OR PREMISES OR PART THEREOF WHERE ANYTHING IN VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE PLACED OR SHALL EXIST, AND ANY ARCHITECT, BUILDER, CONTRACTOR, AGENT, PERSON OR CORPORATION EMPLOYED IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, WHO MAY HAVE ASSISTED IN THE COMMISSION OF ANY SUCH VIOLATION SHALL BE GUILTY OF A SEPARATE OFFENSE AND UPON CONVICTION MAY BE FINED NOT MORE THAN \$100.00 AND EACH DAY SUCH VIOLATION EXISTS SHALL CONSTITUTE A SEPARATE OFFENSE. PASSED AND APPROVED 23 OCTOBER, 1947.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That an ordinance entitled "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ZONING REGULATIONS AND DISTRICTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, ETC.", passed and approved by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio on the 3rd day of November, A.D. 1938, be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

8. The City Clerk shall publish the descriptive caption of this ordinance which states in summary the purpose of the ordinance and the penalty for violation thereof, 10 times in the "COMMERCIAL RECORDER", a newspaper published in the City of San Antonio.

AN ORDINANCE TO USE THE CITY SANITARY SEWERS BY A CONNECTION OUTSIDE OF THE CITY LIMITS, ON THE PETITION OF JOHN F. CUNNINGHAM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. That the peition of John F. Cunningham, for a license to use the sanitary sewerage system of the City of San Antonio is granted hereby, subject to the following precedent conditions.
2. That the permit hereby granted is temporaty and the City reserves the right to re-voke same at any time, with or without notice.
3. The house plumbing and the connection with the City sewer shall be made and maintained at the cost and risk of the Licensee, in conformity with the ordinances of the City of San Antonio.
4. AN ORDINANCE 6402

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO GUY A. THOMPSON, TRUSTEE, INTERNATIONAL-GREAT NORTHERN RAILROAD COMPANY, DEBTOR, THE RIGHT, PRIVILEGE AND FRANCHISE OF CONSTRUCTING, MAINTAINING AND OPERATING CERTAIN RAILWAY TRACK IN AND ALONG SAN MARCOS STREET AND ACROSS LAUREL STREET IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS, AND PRESCRIBING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SAID RIGHT, PRIVILEGE AND FRANCHISE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS:

Sec. 1. That the right, privilege and franchise be, and the same is hereby, granted to GUY A. THOMPSON, TRUSTEE, INTERNATIONAL-GREAT NORTHERN RAILROAD COMPANY, DEBTOR, his successors, assigns, lessees, licensees and invites, to construct and thereafter maintain, repair, operate and use a certain railway spur track in and along San Marcos Street, and across Laurel Street, the center line of said track being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center line of Railroad Company's main line track, which point is southerly 25 feet, more or less, from the South line of Laurel Street, measured along said center line, and a distance of 10 feet, more or less, westerly from the East Line of San Marcos Street, at San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas:

Thense Northeasterly on a curve to the right having a radius of 459.28 feet, a distance of 72.9 feet to a point which is the intersection of the East line of San Marcos Street with the North line of Laurel Street.

Sec. 2. This ordinance is granted for the purpose of reaching and affording railway facilities, connections and loading and switching privileges to owners or users of industrial plants or business enterprises situated near or in the vicinity of said track to be located, in part, upon the locations mentioned in Sec. 1 hereof.

Sec. 3. That said railway track, above mentioned, may be used by the trains, engines and cars owned and/or operated by said Guy A. Thompson, Trustee, International-Great Northern Railroad Company, Debtor, his successors, assigns, licensees and invitees, and such trains, engines and cars shall be so operated thereover as not to interfere, unreasonably, with public travel upon, along, or across the street occupied thereby, or any portion thereof; and, except so far as may be reasonably necessary in the switching, movement, storage and handling of cars, the said street shall be kept clear, and no cars shall be permitted to remain standing on such streets except as aforesaid.

Sec. 4. That said Railroad Company shall, at its own expense, install, maintain, and keep in repair all ditches, drains and culverts made necessary for the proper drainage of said streets by the construction of said track; and will, at its own expense, repair and place in its condition, as immediately before the installation of said track, that part of the said street over, across, and upon which said track may be installed.

Sec. 5. Should said streets be paved or otherwise improved, said Railroad Company, by the acceptance hereof, agrees to pay the cost of paving or improving the portion of said street lying between the rails of said track and two (2) feet on each side thereof, for all excavation and foundation made necessary by reason of the existence of the track thereon. The Railroad Company shall, at all times, so as to maintain said track, together with paving or other surfacing of the street within the rails thereof and for a space of two (2) feet outside of each rail thereof, so that the crossings will be smooth and will constitute no danger, hazard or obstruction to persons using or vehicles passing along said street. Nothing herein contained, however, shall limit any right or power of the City to require payment for paving or improving in addition to the amount herein expressly agreed to.

Sec. 6. The franchise hereby granted shall become effective upon the Railroad Company filing with the City Secretary of the City of San Antonio its acceptance hereof in writing within thirty (30) days after final passage of this ordinance, and shall continue for a term of ten (10) years thereafter. Failure to exercise the rights herein granted within said thirty day period, or subsequent abandonment or discontinuance of the use of said track, or failure to comply with any of the material terms, obligations, provisions or requirements of this ordinance shall annul the same and work as a forfeiture of all rights and privileges herein granted.

Sec. 7. Upon the expiration of said term, the City of San Antonio may, at its option, require the Railroad Company to remove said track and to replace the street in such condition and repair as existed at the time of said installation or at the time of said removal, all of which is to be done at the expense of said Railroad Company.

A RESOLUTION

DECLARING THE CANVASS AND THE RESULT OF A SPECIAL ELECTION ON THE 30TH OF DECEMBER, 1947, TO DETERMINE WHETHER OR NOT HOUSE BILL 34 PASSED AT THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE FIFTIETH LEGISLATURE TO CREATE A FIREMEN'S AND POLICEMEN'S CIVIL SERVICE IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO BE ADOPTED: AND TO AMEND THE CITY CHARTER OF SAN ANTONIO TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF REVENUE BONDS TO FINANCE AUTOMOBILE PARKING STATIONS AND MARKET HOUSES AND MARKET PLACES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

1. Came on regularly to be canvassed, on this the 31st day of December, 1947, the day after the special election to determine whether or not House Bill 34 passed at the Regular Session of the Fiftieth Legislature to create a Firemen's and Policemen's Civil Service in the City of San Antonio be adopted, and to amend the City Charter of San Antonio to authorize the issue of revenue bonds to finance automobile parking stations and market houses and market places, the returns of the special municipal election held on the 30th day of December, 1947, at which election there were submitted to the qualified voters of said City, two propositions, as follows: First Proposition - Creation of Firemen's and Policemen's Civil Service by the adoption of House Bill 34 passed at the Regular Session of the Fiftieth Legislature, and, Second Proposition - To amend the City Charter of San Antonio to authorize the issue of revenue bonds to finance automobile parking stations and market houses and market places; as fully set out in the Ordinance ordering said election passed and approved on the 29th day of November, A.D. 1947, and as set out in the Proclamation and Notice of Election promulgated by the Mayor on the 29th day of November, 1947, posted at the several voting places in the precincts in said City and published in the "SAN ANTONIO LIGHT", as required by law, and the Mayor and Commissioners having met to canvass the returns and to declare the result of said election in the manner provided by law, and after considering, determining and canvassing all the matters of fact thereto appertaining; and,

2. WHEREAS, said returns were canvassed by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio and the result of said election declared at their meeting held in the Council Chamber at the City Hall in said City, on the 31st day of December, 1947, from which it appears that said First Proposition to create a Firemen's and Policemen's Civil Service in the City of San Antonio by the adoption of House Bill 34 passed at the Regular Session of the Fiftieth Legislature was approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting at said election, and that said Second Proposition to amend the City Charter of the City of San Antonio to authorize the issue of revenue bonds to finance automobile parking stations and market houses and market places, was not approved by a majority vote of the qualified voters voting at said election, the respective votes cast in favor of and against said Propositions, as appears from said returns, and said canvass, being as follows, to-wit:

And it appearing to the Board of Commissioners that said First Proposition to create a Firemen's and Policemen's Civil Service in the City of San Antonio, by the adoption of House Bill 34 passed at the Regular Session of the Fiftieth Legislature, was submitted and that the special election was held and was conducted as required by the Statutes of the State of Texas and the Charter and Ordinances of the City of San Antonio; and, that at said special election there were cast on said First Proposition to create a Firemen's and Policemen's Civil Service in the City of San Antonio, the aggregate number of votes marked "FOR" and the aggregate number of votes marked "AGAINST", all as shown by the report of the canvass of said returns by the Board of Commissioners, and said returns having been found to be correct in all respects, it is declared that the First Proposition to create a Firemen's and Policemen's Civil Service in the City of San Antonio by the adoption of House Bill 34 passed at the Regular Session of the Fiftieth Legislature, was adopted by a majority vote, of the qualified voters at said election; and the provisions of said Act are declared in effect in the City of San Antonio.

4. And it appearing to the Board of Commissioners that said Second Proposition to amend the City Charter of the City of San Antonio to authorize the issue of revenue bonds to finance automobile parking stations and market houses and market places, was submitted and that the special election was held and was conducted as required by the Statutes of the State of Texas and the Charter and Ordinances of the City of San Antonio; and, that as said special election there was cast on said Second Proposition to amend the City Charter of the City of San Antonio to authorize the issue of revenue bonds to finance automobile parking stations and market houses and places, the aggregate number of votes marked "FOR" and the aggregate number of votes marked "AGAINST", all as shown by the report and the canvass of said returns by the Board of Commissioners, and said returns having been found to be correct in all respects, it is declared that said Second Proposition to amend the City Charter of the City of San Antonio to authorize the issue of revenue bonds to finance automobile parking stations and market houses and market places, was not adopted by a majority vote of the qualified voters at said election.
