

AN ORDINANCE      2011-04-07-0279

**AUTHORIZING A FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH THE SCHOOL OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY AND ACCEPTING FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$8,000.00 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF TWO ROAD SIDE MOUNTED SOLAR POWERED FLASHING BEACONS NEAR THE SCHOOL OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY CAMPUS LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 10.**

**WHEREAS**, the **School of Science and Technology**, located at 1450 NE Loop 410, wishes to install two road side mounted solar powered flashing beacons assemblies, one along the NE Loop 410 frontage road and one on the 8300 block of N. Vandiver ; and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated costs for construction and installation of the flashing beacon assemblies is \$16,000.00 and the **School of Science and Technology** has agreed to fund 50% of the cost and the other 50% will be provided by the City through the School Flashing Beacon Challenge funded through the Advanced Transportation District (ATD) Program; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance authorizes the execution of a funding agreement with **School of Science and Technology** and accepts funds up to \$8,000.00 that will be used towards the construction and installation of the flashing beacons; and

**WHEREAS**, approval of this Ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to collaborate with other agencies in the development and construction of City infrastructure; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to execute a funding agreement and accept funds in an amount up to \$8,000.00 from **School of Science and Technology** for the installation of two road side mounted school flashing beacons.

**SECTION 2.** The following financial adjustments are hereby authorized to effect this Ordinance:

- a) Funds are authorized to be received from School of Science and Technology to SAP Fund 40099000, Other Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 23-01121, ATD-School Crosswalk Beacons, shall be revised by increasing SAP WBS element 23-01121-90-03, School of Science and Technology Contribution, SAP GL Account 4502280, Contribution from other Agencies, by the amount of \$8,000.00.
- b) The amount of \$8,000.00 is appropriated in SAP Fund 40099000, Other Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 23-01121, ATD-School Crosswalk Beacons, SAP WBS Element 23-01121-06-01, Construction, SAP GL Account 5301010.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.






