I respectfully request that the Planning and Development Services Department take the appropriate steps in bringing forward to the appropriate committees an amendment to the Major Thoroughfare Plan by upgrading the designation of Goliad Road to a Secondary Arterial Type B (which requires 70-86 feet of right-of-way) from Pecan Valley to Loop 410 South.

Brief Background

Development has significantly increased on this corridor and is expected to continue in the near future with new multi-family developments. To adequately and safely accommodate future growth between Pecan Valley and Loop 410 South, this upgrade to Goliad Road on the Major Thoroughfare Plan is requested.
