

## SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 30th, 1924 at 10:00 O'clock.

PRESENT: Honorable John W. Tobin, Mayor, presiding and Commissioners, Lambert, Steffler, Wright. Absent, Bushick.

The Mayor announced the purpose of the meeting to be the passage and approval of an ordinance directing the condemnation of certain property on Guadalupe Street, and the transactions of such other business as might properly come before it. Whereupon Commissioner Steffler submitted the following ordinances which were read and adopted by the following vote on roll call to-wit; Ayes, Tobin, Lambert, Steffler, Wright.

## AN ORDINANCE

DIRECTING CONDEMNATION OF PROPERTY BELONGING TO ANGELINA MARINELLI AND OTHERS, ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF GUADALUPE STREET AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH SOUTH LAREDO STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio,

SECTION 1. That a public necessity exists requiring the widening, opening and extending of Guadalupe Street easterly from South Laredo Street, and therefor the appropriation of the following described property, out of Lot No. 1, City Block 921, within the corporate limits of the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of City Block 921, which is also the northwest corner of lot No. 1, on the present old south line of Guadalupe Street.

Thence in an easterly direction along the present old south line of Guadalupe Street, a distance of 111.1 feet to the present northeast corner of lot No. 1.

Thence in a southerly direction along the east line of lot 1, a distance of 8 feet to a point on the new established south line of Guadalupe Street for the southeast corner of this street.

Thence in a westerly direction with the new established south line of Guadalupe Street, a distance of 111.1 feet to a point on the east line of South Laredo Street for the southwest corner of this tract.

Thence in a northerly direction with the present east line of South Laredo Street, a distance of 8 feet to the place of beginning.

According to plat of the property proposed to be condemned, which is herewith filed with the City Clerk.

SECTION 2. Said property being owned and claimed by Angelina Marinelli, Adelaide Marinelli, Annie Marinelli, Joe Marinelli and Maria Marinelli; all residents of the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas.

SECTION 3. That said property, and the fee thereof, be condemned for the use of the City of San Antonio for the aforesaid purposes, and the City Attorney is hereby directed to proceed in accordance with Section 98, of the City Charter, and the laws of the State of Texas, for the condemnation of said property for the purposes aforesaid.

## AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING DEED FROM SMITH BROTHERS DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, FOR WIDENING GARDEN STREET.

WHEREAS, on the 13th day of October, A. D. 1924, Smith Brothers Development Company deeded and dedicated a parcel of land out of New City Block 986, containing 670.67 square feet of land along the west side of Garden Street south of Mill Bridge, as recorded in Record Book No. 6, page 196, City Engineer's Office, to the City of San Antonio; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the City of San Antonio accepts the said deed and dedication of said property, and directs the City Engineer to record the same in the records of his office.

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## AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING THE EXTENSION OF VILLITA STREET FROM SMITH BROTHERS DEVELOPMENT COMPANY.

WHEREAS, on the 13th day of October, A. D. 1924, Smith Brothers Development Company deeded and dedicated a part of New City Block 986, between the west property line of Garden Street and east property line of St. Mary's Street, 55 feet in width and 358.98 feet along the north line and 317.94 feet along the south line, to the City of San Antonio; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the City of San Antonio accepts the said deed and dedication of said property, and directs the City Engineer to record the same in the records of his office.

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Commissioner Steffler, introduced the following resolutions, which were read and adopted.

## RESOLUTION

Electing Phil Wright Acting Mayor.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, Phil Wright, Commissioner of Fire and Police, be and he is hereby elected to assume the duties of Acting Mayor, for the period covered by the absence of Hon. Jno. W. Tobin, Mayor, from the City, and that the Mayor be granted five days leave of absence from City.

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## RESOLUTION

Authorizing the purchase of a Hudson Coach Automobile for use of the Mayor.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the City Purchasing Agent be and he is hereby authorized to purchase one Hudson Coach Automobile for use by the Mayor and that the Hudson open car heretofore used by the Mayor be transferred to service in the Police Department.

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On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
