Commissioner of Taxation:

The petitions (5) of the International Bible College, Inc., & (1) for Emanuel Church President, requesting the exemption of City taxes on the following described properties:

turned by the Zoning Commission and referred to the Zoning Board of Adjustment.


On a motion by Commissioner Knight, seconded by Commissioner Davis, the recommenda-
