SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, HELD IN THE MAYOR'S OFFICE, CITY HALL, SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, AT 11:00 O'CLOCK, A. M. ON SATURDAY, APRIL 22ND, 1944.

PRESENT: Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein and Anderson. ABSENT: Steffler. Mayor Mauermann presiding.

TO THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

Gentlemen:

By virtue of the authority vested in me by the Charter of the City of San Antonio, I hereby call you in Special Session, to be held at 11:00 o'clock, A. M. on April 22, 1944, in the Mayor's Office of the City Hall of San Antonio, Texas, to consider and act upon the following:

'AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$793.50 OUT OF 1943 GENERAL FUND - VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS - TO PAY FOR INDEPENDENT HIRE OF TEAMS AND TRUCKS.'
