Minutes of previous meeting was ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

Petition for improvement of Pruitt Ave, was read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements.

Petition of Geo. S. Rumbaugh for reduction of taxes, was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police: Magnolia Petroleum Co. to install gasoline tanks at N. Laredo and N. Flores Sts.

No. 230 **MC-624** AN ORDINANCE
Appropriating \$2,500.00 to pay J. Ben Stoner.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Special Emergency and Contingency Fund, warrant for which shall be made payable to J. Ben Stoner as partial payment on land computation work in connection with the revision of the Somers System of Taxation.

No. 231 **- 625** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriat \$411.80 out of the 1918 General Fund to pay for feeding prisoners during month of October 1918 as per itemized statement on file in office of City Auditor.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of Four Hundred, eleven and 80/100 Dollars (\$411.80) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and is, hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to pay Eva McIntosh for furnishing 2059 meals to City prisoners in City jail during month of October 1918 per itemized statement on file in office of City Auditor.

Commissioner Coy recommended that petition of Western Paving Co. for reduction of assessment be granted. Adopted.

Commissioner Wright recommended that petition of A. C. Sien for special building permit be granted. Adopted.

Commissioner Wright introduced the following resolution, which was adopted.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the San Antonio Public Service Company is hereby ordered to place 1 250 W. Street lamp at the intersection of Waco Street and Florea Avenue, and also move 1 250 W. lamp from the intersection of Waco Street & Wooley Avenue one pole east on Waco Street.

No. 232 **MC-626** AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$53/25 to be paid to Fred Fries, City Clerk.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$53.25 be and is hereby appropriated out of the 1918 General Fund to be paid Fred Fries City Clerk for sums paid out of the Contingency Fund on fines remitted and ordered refunded by the Mayor.
