

AN ORDINANCE 2012-09-20-0738

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PAUL S. SARBANES TRANSIT IN PARKS GRANT PROGRAM, IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$300,000.00, FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE MISSION REACH PHASE 2 BIKE SHARE EXPANSION NEAR THE SAN ANTONIO MISSIONS NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK, PROVIDING FOR THE ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS UPON AWARD, APPROVING A PROJECT BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH SAN ANTONIO BIKE SHARE

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WHEREAS, in February 2012, the City was awarded a grant of \$324,000.00 through the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Paul S. Sarbanes 2011 Transit in Parks Program for the Mission Reach B-Cycle Bike Share Expansion project, as authorized by Ordinance 2011-05-05-0349; and

WHEREAS, the DOT FTA has advertised the Paul S. Sarbanes 2012 Transit in Parks Grant Program to continue to address the challenges of increased vehicle congestion and pollution in and around national parks, and the City will apply to receive a grant up to an additional \$300,000.00 to develop the Mission Reach Phase 2; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2010-06-17-0563 authorized a contract with the non-profit San Antonio Bike Share to implement, manage and operate the Bike Share program launched in March 2011 in and around the downtown and Ordinance 2011-05-05-0349 authorized San Antonio Bike Share to implement, fund and operate the Mission Reach Bike Share expansion; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance authorizes the submittal of an application to the DOT FTA Paul S. Sarbanes 2012 Transit in Parks Grant Program for a grant up to \$300,000.00 for the development of the Mission Reach Phase 2 Bike Share Expansion near the San Antonio Missions National Historical Park, the acceptance of funds upon award, approves a budget, authorizes the Director of the Office of Environmental Policy (OEP), or his designee, to execute all related grant documents, and also authorizes an amendment to the City's current contract with San Antonio Bike Share to provide for implementation, funding and operation of the Mission Reach Phase 2 expansion; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, or the Director, Office of Environmental Policy (OEP), or his designee, is hereby authorized to apply for and accept funds from the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) Paul S. Sarbanes 2012 Transit in Parks Grant Program, in an amount up to \$300,000.00, for the development of the Mission Reach Phase 2 expansion. The City Manager, or her designee, or the Director, OEP, or his designee, is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate the application and acceptance of grant funds. A copy of the application is on file with the OEP.

SECTION 2. The Director, OEP, or his designee, is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an amendment to the current contract with San Antonio Bike Share for the implementation, funding and operation of the Mission Reach Phase 2 expansion. The OEP is authorized to use the grant funds to reimburse San Antonio Bike Share for services for the implementation of the Mission Reach Phase 2 expansion. The OEP is authorized to make revisions or deviate from the budget as necessary to comply with local, state and federal regulations applicable to the implementation of the grant program, to be supported by written justification, and where applicable, consistent with program guidelines and the concurrence of DOT.

SECTION 3. This ordinance authorizes the application and acceptance of grant funds in an amount up to \$300,000.00 from the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) to provide implementation, funding and operation of the Mission Reach Phase 2 expansion. If awarded, monies will be made payable to San Antonio B-Cycle upon amending of the Purchase Order.

SECTION 4. Upon approval of this ordinance, a new fund and internal order number will be created, upon which the above sum of \$300,000.00 will be appropriated from DOT. The proposed budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**, is approved and adopted for entry in the City books.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage hereof.




