

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, HELD IN
THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CITY HALL, ON
THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 19, 1987.

The meeting was called to order at 3:15 P.M. by the presiding officer, Mayor Henry Cisneros, with the following members present: BERRIOZABAL, WEBB, DUTMER, WING, MARTINEZ, THOMPSON, VERA, LABATT, HASSLOCHER, CISNEROS. Absent: HARRINGTON.

87-10 Mayor Cisneros briefly explained the substance of the Ordinance in question and spoke to the \$28 million settlement that has already been received in this lawsuit.

Mrs. Dutmer spoke to the need to have the city streets properly repaired by the City Water Board and the situation as it stands especially in the Highland Park area.

Mayor Cisneros asked the City Manager to see if there are areas still in San Antonio without water service. He understands from Mr. Robert Van Dyke, General Manager of the City Water Board, that the only remaining non watered area inside the city limits is the East Commerce Estates addressed earlier in the day by the City Council by ordinance. He asked the City Manager for a list of any other areas if the city knows of them.

Mrs. Berriozabal submitted Landa Street area as one of the areas not now receiving city water.

Mr. Fox stated that Mrs. Terec Caldwell-Johnson would be responsible for collecting these lists from City Councilmembers.

87-10 The Clerk read the following Ordinance:
