MONDAY, JULY 9th, A. D. 1923, 4 P. M.

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating \$1885.88 to pay Special Merchants Bills.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of \$1885.88 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1923 General Fund to pay San Antonio Sewer Pipe Company for 715 feet of 24 inch sewer pipe \$1389.88, and to pay San Antonio Portland Cement Co. for one car of Cement \$496.00 as per itemized invoices duly approved and now on file in the office of the City Auditor.

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating (\$10,000.00) Ten Thousand Dollars to pay Uvalde Rock Asphalt Co. for paving Fredericksburg Road from Cincinnati Ave. to Martinez Creek Bridge.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that, the sum of (\$10,000.00) Ten Thousand Dollars is hereby appropriated from 1922 Gen. Fund (St. Com. Dept.) to pay Uvalde Rock Asphalt Co. for paving Fredericksburg Road from Cincinnati Ave. to Martinez Creek Bridge.

AN ORDINANCE

Appropriating the sum of \$2600 to pay Kenneth Wimer for certain improvements upon portions of Day Avenues, Gaines Avenue, Murphy Avenue, Gorden Avenue, Cook Avenue and Flood Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, that,

SECTION ONE: That the sum of \$2600 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund to pay Kenneth Wimer for certain work and improvements done or caused to be done by the said Kenneth Wimer on Day Avenue, Gaines Avenue, Murphey Avenue, Cook Avenue and Flood Avenue, in accordance with agreement heretofore entered into by the said Kenneth Wimer and the City of San Antonio.

SECTION TWO: As a part of this ordinance it is provided that .

WHEREAS: on account of certain work done by the City of San Antonio as a part of said agreement, said Kenneth Wimer has become indebted to the City of San Antonio in the total sum of \$2102.15, the City Auditor is authorized and instructed to draw proper warrant for said sum of \$2600 payable to the said Kenneth Wimer to be delivered to the said Kenneth Wimer only when said Kenneth Wimer shall pay to the City of San Antonio the said sum of \$2102.15, all as per agreement between Kenneth Wimer and the City of San Antonio heretofore duly authorized by the Commissioners of the City of San Antonio.

The Report of the City Engineer on the proposal of T.W. Masterson with reference to the improvement of certain land owned by him. read and referred to the City Attorney.

An Ordinance vacating certain streets which have never been formally accepted by the City. was introduced read and referred to the City Attorney.

On motion of Mayor TOBIN It was determined that during the summer months no meetings of the Commissioners be held on Thursday of each week, unless necessary through the accumulation of business which should be transacted.

On motion, duly seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
