

AN ORDINANCE 2009-09-17-0731L

AMENDING THE EXISTING FEES SET OUT IN THE CITY CODE,
CHAPTER 29, SECTION 29-168 AND AMENDING THE CITY CODE TO
REFLECT SUCH CHANGES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Code of San Antonio, Texas, Chapter 29, Article IV, Excavations, Division 3. COSTS, FEES AND ENFORCEMENT, Section 29-168 (j) is hereby amended by adding language that is underlined and ~~striking~~ deleted language as follows:

DIVISION 3. COSTS FEES AND ENFORCEMENT

Sec. 29-168. Fees.

* * * * *

(j) *Barricade fees.*

Barricades, on city streets (including sidewalks and alleys) per sq. ft. <u>of closure</u> per day	\$0.0525	<u>\$0.0629</u>
Barricades in traveled portion of city streets between curbs including sidewalk and alley, per sq. ft. per day, minimum	\$50.00	
Private barricading of streets or portions of streets, per block <u>of roadway closed</u> , per day <u>of closure</u> (block parties)	\$75.00	<u>\$100.00</u>

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SECTION 2. The individual revenue adjustment items included herein propose to increase revenues in the General Fund and have been included in the FY 2010 Proposed Budget Document.

SECTION 3. Should any article, section, part, paragraph, sentence, phrase, clause, or word of this Ordinance, or any appendix hereof, for any reason, be held illegal, or invalid, or any exception to or limitation upon any general provision contained in this Ordinance or its attachments or held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder shall, nevertheless, stand as effective and as valid as if it had been enacted and ordained without the portion held to be unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk for the City of San Antonio is hereby directed to publish notice of this Ordinance as required by the Charter of the City of San Antonio and the laws of the State of Texas.

SECTION 5. The publishers of the City Code are authorized to amend and format said Codes to reflect the changes adopted herein. In the event that the subsection assigned above has been previously assigned by Ordinance or by the publisher, then, in that event, the publisher is authorized to renumber the addition made by this section with the next available number.

SECTION 6. All new, revised or repealed fees shall be effective October 1, 2009.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.


