RESOLUTION

WHEREAS San Antonio, in common with many other American Cities, appears to be suffering unduly from preventable and unnecessary noises and din and clatter of every description, some of which are cheap ballyhoo, much of it common street advertising, such as commercial radio and loud speakers, the ringing of bells, blowing of whistles, sounding of horns and beating of drums to attract attention to purely private matters, all of which tend to disturb the peace and serenity of the community, especially in the residential district and schools and hospitals zones, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney, City Health Officer and the Chief of Police be directed to make a survey to consider the question of suppressing unnecessary noises in the City of San Antonio. That such investigation be conducted along the lines ascertaining, (1) Causes of unnecessary noises; (2) How and why they should be abated; (3) Existing San Antonio Ordinances with regard to noises; and (4) Specific recommendation for additional Ordinances that may be necessary, or for the enforcement of old Ordinances, if no new Ordinances are found to be necessary.
