SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, HELD IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER OF THE CITY HALL, AT ELEVEN O'CLOCK, A.M., ON WEDNESDAY, MAY NINTH, 1945.

PRESENT: Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Anderson. ABSENT: Steffler. Mayor Mauermann presiding.

The Clerk read the call, as follows:

The canvass of the returns was begun and continued until 1:30 P.M., at which time, on motion of Commissioner Callaghan, seconded by Commissioner Hein and carried by roll call vote, to-wit: Ayes, Mauermann, Callaghan, Hein, Anderson; Nay, Steffler (absent), the meeting was recessed until 4:00 o'clock, P. M., this same date. The canvass had been completed by 1:30 o'clock, P. M., and the recess was ordered to allow the City Attorney time to prepare the necessary ordinance to declare the statement of canvass and result of election.
