

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, AUGUST 19TH, 1915.

AT FOUR O'CLOCK, P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Clinton G. Brown, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Garland, Lambert, and Kearny. Absent, Steves.

Minutes of the previous meeting were ordered approved.

MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS.

The petition of J. L. Lytle regarding paving assessment on Porter Street was read and ordered filed.

The petition of property owners on Victoria Street protesting against paving of Street was read and ordered filed.

On motion of Commissioner Lambert, duly seconded and carried, public hearings of property owners interested in street improvements on the following named streets were held. Aransas Avenue, (from Hackberry Street to Porter Street) Victoria Street, (from Peach Street to Hackberry Street) Porter Street, (from Pine Street to Mittman Street) Grayson Street, (from lower gate of Army Post to North New Braunfels Avenue) Goliad Street, (from South Alamo Street to Peach Street) North Hackberry Street, (from East Commerce Street to Grayson Street) Peach Street, (from Goliad Street to Victoria Street) South Hackberry Street, (from Victoria Street to Denver Boulevard).

On motion of Commissioner Lambert, duly seconded and carried, the hearing closed. For full report of said hearings see Record Book kept by the City Clerk for that purpose.

Commissioner Lambert recommended that the petition of Mrs. Flourey, for permit to conduct tenement houses, be granted. Adopted.

Commissioner Lambert recommended that the petition of F. G. Reiden, for permit to establish slaughter house be granted, on the condition that sewers be installed at once. Adopted.

Commissioner Lambert recommended that the following petitions be granted. adopted.

MA-147 For water mains on McKinley Avenue.

-148 For water mains on Cooper and Vine Streets.

-149 For water mains on Roseborough Street.

-150 For water mains on Speed Street from Colorado Street to Brazos Street.

Commissioner Garland recommended that the petition of Rudolph E. Cadwalder for refund of taxes, be not granted. adopted.

MA-151 Commissioner Garland, recommended that the petition of C. D. Newton, for correction of assessment, be granted. Adopted.

An ordinance providing for settlement of judgement of the San Antonio School Board against the City of San Antonio, was introduced and ordered laid over.

Commissioner Kearny introduced the following ordinance, which was read and adopted by the following vote on roll-call, to-wit: Ayes, Brown, Garland, Lambert Kearny. Nays, None.

MA-152 AN ORDINANCE.

THE STATE OF TEXAS
COUNTY OF BEXAR
CITY OF SAN ANTONIO.

An ordinance accepting proposal of the Chicago Bridge & Iron Company for furnishing and erecting steel flume across San Antonio River, and authorizing contract and appropriating money therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section One. (ACCEPTANCE) That the City does hereby accept the attached written proposal of said party named in the caption hereof, dated April 19th, 1915, and offering to furnish and erect a five foot diameter steel flume approximately 1554 feet long across the San Antonio River near the fair grounds for sewer purposes, in and for said City in accordance with the written specifications and descriptions and drawings prepared and submitted by the said Chicago Bridge and Iron Company, provided said party making said proposal shall strictly comply with all requirements made by or under the provisions of this ordinance and all instruments herein referred to, which are made a part hereof.

Section Two. (BONDS) That the Mayor is hereby authorized to require and approve on behalf of the City proper bond or bonds for the performance and completion of said undertakings.

Section Three. (CONTRACT, ETC.) That the Mayor is hereby authorized to cause and require the execution and delivery of a written contract to be drawn in accordance with said proposal, and the terms and conditions understood and required as applicable to said matter.

Section Four. (APPROPRIATION) That to defray the costs and expenses to be paid by the City by reason of the premises, the sum of Thirty Four Thousand Two Hundred (\$34,200.00) Dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1915 General Fund.

Section Five. That an ordinance passed and approved June 25th, A.D., 1915, appropriating thirty four thousand two hundred (\$34,200.00) Dollars out of funds derived from the sale of bonds of the City dated September 1st, 1913, to pay Chicago Bridge and Iron Company for furnishing and erecting steel flume across San Antonio River for outfall sewer, is hereby repealed.

On motion duly seconded and carried, meeting recessed.
