

AN ORDINANCE **76476**

AMENDING CITY CODE CHAPTER 13, ENTITLED "FOOD AND FOOD HANDLERS", REVISING THE COSTS OF AND ADDING PROVISIONS FOR CERTAIN FEES AND PERMITS; AND AMENDING CITY CODE CHAPTER 15, ENTITLED "HEALTH", REVISING DENTAL CLINIC FEES AND ADDING A SECTION FOR HEALTH INSPECTION FEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Code of the City of San Antonio is hereby amended to add the following section:

Sec. 13-17. Replacement of License, Permits and Certificates

The Health Department shall collect a \$5.00 fee for the replacement of any lost, damaged or otherwise absent license, permit or certificate issued under any section of Chapter 13 of the City Code. All fees collected shall be deposited into the general fund of the city.

SECTION 2. Section 13-39 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 13-39. Fees enumerated.

The annual license fee to cover the cost of inspection of such food establishments shall be paid in advance upon issuance of such license as follows:

- (1) For each establishment employing not more than three (3) persons \$85.00
- (2) More than three (3) persons and not more than six (6) persons \$200.00
- (3) More than six (6) persons and not more than ten (10) persons \$400.00
- (4) More than ten (10) persons and not more than twenty-five (25) persons \$600.00
- (5) More than twenty-five (25) persons and not more than fifty (50) persons \$800.00
- (6) More than fifty (50) persons \$1,000.00

SECTION 3. Section 13-176 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio is hereby amended to add the following:

(c) A fee of sixty dollars (\$60.00) shall be charged upon the reinstatement of any permit issued under Section 13-176.

SECTION 4. Section 13-204 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 13-204. Amount of permit fees.

(a) The annual permit fee to cover the cost of inspection of a food service establishment shall be paid in advance upon issuance of such permit as follows:

- (1) For each establishment employing not more than three (3) persons \$85.00
- (2) More than three (3) persons and not more than six (6) persons \$200.00
- (3) More than six (6) persons and not more than ten (10) persons \$400.00
- (4) More than ten (10) persons and not more than twenty-five (25) persons \$600.00
- (5) More than twenty-five (25) persons and not more than fifty (50) persons \$800.00
- (6) More than fifty (50) persons \$1,000.00

SECTION 5. Section 13-356 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 13-356. Permit fees.

The annual permit fee to cover the cost of inspection of a retail food store shall be paid in advance upon issuance of such permit as follows:

- (1) For each establishment employing not more than three (3) persons \$85.00
- (2) More than three (3) persons and not more than six (6) persons \$200.00
- (3) More than six (6) persons and not more than ten (10) persons \$400.00
- (4) More than ten (10) persons and not more than twenty-five (25) persons \$600.00

(5) More than twenty-five (25) persons and not more than fifty (50) persons \$800.00

(6) More than fifty (50) persons \$1,000.00

SECTION 6. Section 15-2 (a) of the City Code of the City of San Antonio is hereby amended to read as follows:


(a) In cases of appropriate covered Medicaid Dental Services the city dental clinic fee will equal the community's prevailing Medicaid reimbursement rate. Fees will be assessed on a sliding scale based on the patient's family income. In addition to the sliding fee scale all patients will be required to pay a four dollar (\$4.00) appointment fee. No patient otherwise qualified to receive dental health clinic services will be denied said services based on an ability to pay the established fees.

SECTION 7. Section 15-2 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio is hereby amended to add the following:


(d) All individuals, organizations and/or businesses requesting Health Department inspections for any type of facility or establishment not currently regulated or licensed elsewhere in the City Code shall pay a twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) fee for each inspection. All fees shall be paid before the inspections are performed. Fees collected under this section shall be deposited into the city general fund.

SECTION 8. All adjusted fees and newly established fees set out in this ordinance shall become effective October 1, 1992.
