ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE SECURITIES PLEDGED BY THE ALAMO NATIONAL BANK OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, TO SECURE THE CITY FUNDS DEPOSITED AND TO BE DEPOSITED IN SAID BANK BY THE CITY DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 1936, AND DIRECTING THE DEPOSITING OF SAID SECURITIES FOR SAFE-KEEPING, AND RELEASING THE SECURITIES ON ALL BONDS HERETOFORE GIVEN BY SAID BANK AS CITY DEPOSITORY.

1.
