

AN ORDINANCE **91097**

APPOINTING A REPLACEMENT TO FILL THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF COUNCILMAN JOSE MENENDEZ, WHO RESIGNED EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 22, 1999, AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE UPON THE PASSAGE OF EIGHT AFFIRMATIVE VOTES.

WHEREAS, Councilman Jose Menendez, District 6 representative on the City Council, has submitted his resignation effective December 22, 1999; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Charter, Section 8, a vacancy on the Council is to be filled by a majority vote of the remaining members for the unexpired term; and

WHEREAS, the City Council invited the qualified residents of District 6 to submit letters of interest and resumes to the City Clerk for consideration in being appointed to fill the vacancy created on this Council by the resignation of Councilman Jose Menendez; and

WHEREAS, the City Council interviewed and reviewed the nomination of the following: Lawrence G. Romo, Enrique M. Barrera, Buford J. Tanniehill, Jr., Lucy M. Hall, Esmeralda Valague, Jesse H. Gonzales, Brett D. White, Jesse Zuniga, Jr., Delicia Herrera, and Pete Galaviz on January 6, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Antonio now wishes to appoint a replacement to fill the unexpired City Council term of Jose Menendez, District 6;
NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Enrique M. Barrera is hereby appointed as a member of the City Council, Place No. 6, to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term of Jose Menendez.



Because the citizens of District 6 should not be without representation on the City Council, an emergency is hereby declared so that this ordinance and the appointment made hereby shall be effective immediately upon the affirmative vote of at least eight members of the Council; otherwise, this ordinance shall take effect on the tenth day after passage hereof.

SUMMARY:

This Ordinance will provide for the appointment of a replacement to fill the unexpired term of Councilman Jose Menendez, who resigned effective December 22, 1999, from among the 10 applicants seeking that appointment. Following interviews of the 10 at the City Council meeting of January 6, 2000, it was directed by Council motion to move all 10 as nominees to the City Council agenda of January 13, 2000.

BACKGROUND:

Following direction of City Council subsequent to Councilman Menendez's announced resignation as City Council member, District 6, applications from qualified candidates were sought from the District 6 community. A total of 10 persons submitted qualified applications, and were interviewed by City Council at its January 6, 2000 meeting. It was then directed that the names of all 10 qualified applicants be brought forward to the City Council meeting of January 13, 2000 as nominees to fill that vacant City Council position.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:




RECOMMENDATION:
