

AN ORDINANCE **83885**

APPROVING A PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ALAMO PLAZA EAST FROM CROCKETT TO BLUM, BLUM STREET FROM ALAMO PLAZA EAST TO ALAMO STREET, ALAMO STREET FROM BLUM TO HOUSTON STREET AND OF HOUSTON STREET FROM ALAMO STREET TO ALAMO PLAZA EAST BEGINNING AT 7:00 A.M. UNTIL 10:30 A.M., SATURDAY, JUNE 1, 1996 IN CONNECTION WITH THE CARDIAC BED RACE, SPONSORED BY THE AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION.

WHEREAS, American Heart Association has applied for a parade permit in connection with the Cardiac Bed Race to be held on Saturday, June 1, 1996 from 7:00 a.m. until 10:30 a.m. and has requested the temporary closure of the following streets to vehicular traffic during said time:

Assemble at Alamo Plaza East and Crockett, south on Alamo Plaza East from Crockett to Blum Street, west on Blum from Alamo Plaza East to Alamo Street, north on Alamo Street from Blum to Houston Street then east on Houston Street from Alamo Street to Alamo Plaza East and disband at corner of Alamo Plaza East and Houston Street; and

WHEREAS, the request for the temporary closure of these streets has been evaluated and it has been found that no adverse traffic problems would result, and that the request should be granted in accordance with the City's usual practice and procedure for temporary closures, **NOW THEREFORE;**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the requested parade permit so that **American Heart Association** may hold the Cardiac Bed Race to be held on Saturday, June 1, 1996 beginning at 7:00 a.m. until 10:30 a.m.

SECTION 2. The temporary closure of the following streets to vehicular traffic beginning 7:00 a.m. until 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, June 1, 1996 is hereby authorized:

Assemble at Alamo Plaza East and Crockett, south on Alamo Plaza East from Crockett to Blum Street, west on Blum from Alamo Plaza East to Alamo Street, north on Alamo Street from Blum to Houston Street then east on Houston Street from Alamo Street to Alamo Plaza East and disband at corner of Alamo Plaza East and Houston Street.

SECTION 3. The **American Heart Association** shall be responsible for **a)** all insurance requirements, **b)** obtaining the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, **c)** posting signs, barricades and off-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic and **d)** cleaning up after the event is held.

SECTION 4. By making this special use of these public street right-of-ways, **American Heart Association** shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this usage.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective on the tenth day after the passage hereof.

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

This ordinance will approve the parade permit and authorize the temporary closure of certain streets in connection with the American Heart Association Cardiac Bed Race to be held on June 1, 1996 from 7:00 am - 10:30 am. The parade route is as follows: Assemble at Crockett and Blum (Alamo Plaza), south on Blum from Crockett, north on Alamo from Blum, east on Houston from Alamo, end at Houston and Alamo Plaza.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

All signs, barricades, fees, clean-up, and off-duty police as may be required by the Police Department or the Public Works Department shall be the responsibility of the event sponsor, the American Heart Association.

POLICY ANALYSIS:


This ordinance is consistent with the City policy requiring an ordinance where closures of public streets are requested.

COORDINATION

This event has been coordinated with the City Manager's Office, the Traffic Section of the Police Department, the Traffic Division of the Public Works Department and the Parks and Recreation Department. All of the involved city departments concur with the staff recommendation to approve this request.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

All insurance requirements, public safety devices (signs, barricades) and off-duty police as may be required by the Police Department or the Public Works Department shall be the responsibility of the event sponsor. The City will receive revenues of \$25.00 from this event and will incur no additional costs.
