

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

FRIDAY, December, 1st, 1922, 12 o'clock noon.

PRESENT: Honorable O. B. Black, Mayor, presiding, and Commissioners Pfeiffer, Lambert, Rieden, Wright.

His Honor, the Mayor, announced that the meeting was called for the purpose of discussing bids for the proposed Golf Club House. Bids had been called for Nov. 30, 1922, but the Mayor stated that he had been informed that contractors had not had sufficient time in which to submit bids, and on motion, duly seconded and carried, the Clerk was directed to readvertise for proposals to be submitted Thursday, December 7th, and to state in the advertisement that bids would also be received on the cost plus 10% plan.
