

AN ORDINANCE 11831

DECLARING THE CANVASS AND THE RESULT OF AN ELECTION ON THE 9TH OF MAY, 1950 TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. Came on the 10th day of May, 1950, the day after the election to amend the Charter of the City of San Antonio, regularly to be canvassed, the returns of the special municipal election held on the 9th day of May, 1950, at which election there were submitted to the qualified voters of the City of San Antonio twenty amendments to the Charter of the City of San Antonio as fully set out in the Ordinance ordering said election passed and approved on the 16th day of March, 1950 and as set out in the Election Notice and Proclamation promulgated on the 4th day of April, 1950 posted at the several voting places in the various precincts in said City and published in the COMMERCIAL RECORDER, as require by law, and the Mayor and Commissioners having met to canvass the returns and to declare the result of said election in the manner provided by law, and after considering, determining and canvassing all matters of fact appertaining, we, the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of San Antonio, do hereby find and declare the result of said election to be as tabulated as follows:-

And it appearing to the Board of Commissioners that said amendments were submitted and that the special election was held and was conducted as required by the Statutes of the State of Texas and the Charter and Ordinances of the City of San Antonio; and, that at said special election there were cast on the Propositions submitting the proposed amendments to the Charter, the aggregate number of votes marked "YES" and the aggregate number of votes marked "NO", all as shown by the report and canvass of said returns by the Board of Commissioners, and said returns having been found to be correct in all respects, it is declared that the Propositions were not adopted by a majority vote of the qualified voters at said election.
