

AN ORDINANCE 2007-02-15-0155

ORDERING A BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 12TH DAY OF MAY, 2007, IN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS, ON A PROPOSED BOND ISSUE FOR STREETS, BRIDGES, AND SIDEWALKS IMPROVEMENTS, DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS, PARKS, RECREATION, OPEN SPACES, AND ATHLETICS IMPROVEMENTS, LIBRARY IMPROVEMENTS, AND PUBLIC HEALTH FACILITIES IMPROVEMENTS; SPECIFYING THAT SAID ELECTION SHALL BE HELD JOINTLY WITH OTHER PARTICIPATING LOCAL POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS WITHIN BEXAR COUNTY; MAKING PROVISION FOR THE HOLDING OF THIS ELECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas (the "City") wishes to call a bond election for May 12, 2007 (the "Election"); and

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of numerous other local political subdivisions situated in Bexar County, Texas (the "County"), also intend to call an election for May 12, 2007, and certain of such entities, and the City, wish to hold a joint election as permitted by the provisions of Section 271.002, as amended, Texas Election Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City (the "City Council") hereby finds that the Election should be held to determine whether the City Council shall be authorized to issue bonds of the City in the amounts and for the purposes hereinafter identified and that the Election should be held jointly with the County and all other local political subdivisions choosing to participate;
NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The Election shall be held on Saturday, the 12th day of May, 2007, in accordance with the laws of Texas and the provisions of the Charter of the City (the "City Charter"), and the official ballots for the Election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code and at the Election the following PROPOSITIONS shall be submitted in accordance with law:

STREETS, BRIDGES, AND SIDEWALKS IMPROVEMENTS PROPOSITION

“Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, be authorized to issue bonds of the City in the principal amount of \$306,997,413 for the purpose of making permanent public improvements for public purposes, to wit: providing streets, bridges, and sidewalks improvements (as well as necessary improvements incidental thereto), relocating utilities, street lighting, technology improvements, and signage, and acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary for streets, bridges, and sidewalks, with respect to.

and in providing for the above public improvements, the City Council shall have the option to utilize other funds available for such purposes and, after making due provision for the improvements listed above, the City Council may, in its discretion, use any excess funds for constructing other streets, bridges, and sidewalks improvements (as well as necessary improvements incidental thereto), relocating utilities, street lighting, technology improvements, and signage, and acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary for streets, bridges, and sidewalks; such bonds to mature serially or otherwise not more than forty (40) years from their issued date; and any issue or series of said bonds to bear interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable, or otherwise) as may be determined within the discretion of said City Council; provided, however, that such interest shall not exceed the maximum rate per annum authorized by law at the time of the issuance of any issue or series of said bonds; and shall the City Council be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the annual interest and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity and to pay the costs of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds?"

and in providing for the above public improvements, the City Council shall have the option to utilize other funds available for such purposes and, after making due provision for the improvements listed above, the City Council may, in its discretion, use any excess funds for constructing other drainage facilities for the removal of harmful excesses of water, whether constant or periodic, any other drainage or stormwater improvements, and acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto; such bonds to mature serially or otherwise not more than forty (40) years from their issued date; and any issue or series of said bonds to bear interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable, or otherwise) as may be determined within the discretion of said City Council; provided, however, that such rate of interest shall not exceed the maximum rate per annum authorized by law at the time of the issuance of any issue or series of said bonds; and shall the City Council be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the annual interest and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity and to pay the costs of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds?"

and in providing for the above public improvements, the City Council shall have the option to utilize other funds available for such purposes and, after making due provision for the improvements listed above, the City Council may, in its discretion, use any excess funds for acquiring, constructing, equipping renovating park, cultural, recreation, open space, and athletics improvements, making park additions, and acquiring of lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto, such bonds to mature serially or otherwise not more than forty (40) years from their issued date; and any issue or series of said bonds to bear interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable, or otherwise) as may be determined within the discretion of said City Council; provided, however, that such rate of interest shall not exceed the maximum rate per annum authorized by law at the time of the issuance of any issue or series of said bonds; and shall the City Council be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the annual interest and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity and to pay the costs of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds?"

“Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, be authorized to issue bonds of the City in the principal amount of \$11,025,476 for the purpose of making permanent public improvements for public purposes, to wit: acquiring, constructing, improving, renovating, and/or equipping library facilities, and/or other learning center facilities to be utilized as libraries, and acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto with respect to:

and in providing for the above public improvements, the City Council shall have the option to utilize other funds available for such purposes and, after making due provision for the improvements listed above, the City Council may, in its discretion, use any excess funds for acquiring, constructing, equipping and renovating library facilities and/or other learning center facilities to be utilized as libraries, and acquiring of lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto; such bonds to mature serially or otherwise not more than forty (40) years from their issued date; and any issue or series of said bonds to bear interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable, or otherwise) as may be determined within the discretion of said City Council; provided, however, that such rate of interest shall not exceed the maximum rate per annum authorized by law at the time of the issuance of any issue or series of said bonds; and shall the City Council be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the annual interest and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at

maturity and to pay the costs of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds?"

PUBLIC HEALTH FACILITIES IMPROVEMENTS

PROPOSITION NO. 5

"Shall the City Council of the City of San Antonio, Texas, be authorized to issue bonds of the City in the principal amount of \$800,000 for the purpose of making permanent public improvements for public purposes, to wit: constructing, improving, renovating, and equipping health facilities available to the general public and acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto with respect to:

and in providing for the above public improvements, the City Council shall have the option to utilize other funds available for such purposes and, after making due provision for the improvements listed above, the City Council may, in its discretion, use any excess funds for constructing, equipping, and renovating health facilities available to the general public, and acquiring of lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto; such bonds to mature serially or otherwise not more than forty (40) years from their issued date; and any issue or series of said bonds to bear interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable, or otherwise) as may be determined within the discretion of said City Council, provided that such rate of interest shall not exceed the maximum rate per annum authorized by law at the time of the issuance of any issue or series of said bonds; and shall the City Council be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the annual interest and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity and to pay the costs of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds?"

SECTION 2. The official ballots for the Election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" OR "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITIONS, with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings, and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITIONS to be expressed substantially as follows:

SECTION 3. The City Council hereby authorizes the Election to be held jointly with other participating political subdivisions located within the County, and (pursuant to Ordinance No. 2007-01-04-0016, passed and approved on January 4, 2007) authorizes the execution of an agreement with the County, acting through its Elections Administrator, for conduct of the Election as a joint election with the other political subdivisions identified in such agreement.

SECTION 3. The City Council hereby authorizes the Election to be held jointly with other participating political subdivisions located within the County, and (pursuant to Ordinance No 2007-01-04-0016, passed and approved on January 4, 2007) authorizes the execution of an agreement with the County, acting through its Elections Administrator, for conduct of the Election as a joint election with the other political subdivisions identified in such agreement.

Pursuant to Section 61.012, as amended, Texas Election Code, the Bexar County Elections Administrator shall provide at least one accessible voting system in each polling place used in the Election. Such voting system shall comply with Texas and federal laws establishing the requirements for voting systems that permit voters with physical disabilities to cast a confidential or secret ballot.

SECTION 4. The Election shall be held as prescribed by law at the following voting places in the several precincts of the City, as listed in **Attachment I**, between the hours of 7:00 o'clock a.m. and 7:00 o'clock p.m. on the day of the Election. Attachment I is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 5. Voting at the Election for election day voting shall be done by the use of AIS650 Tabulators, paper ballots or the iVotronic™ touch screen voting system, as determined by the City Clerk of the City and the Bexar County Elections Administrator. The City Clerk does determine hereby that AIS650 Tabulators and paper ballots shall be used for the casting of early votes by mail at the Election. Voting at the Election for early voting by personal appearance shall be done by the use of the iVotronic™ touch screen voting system. The equipment shall be placed at branch offices as listed in **Attachment II**, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes, established for the purpose of conducting early voting by personal appearance during the dates and hours hereby indicated in **Attachment II**.

SECTION 6. Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at the branch offices as listed in Attachment II, during the period for early voting, commencing Monday, April 30, 2007 and ending Tuesday, May 8, 2007, including Saturday, May 5, 2007 and Sunday, May 6, 2007. Hours of early voting shall be established by the Bexar County Elections Administrator in accordance with the applicable provisions of Texas law.

SECTION 7. Electors may cast their early vote by mail, and the Early Voting Clerk's mailing address to which ballot applications and ballots voted by mail shall be sent to, is as follows:

SECTION 8. Notice of such bond election shall be given by posting a substantial copy of this Ordinance, both in English and in Spanish, at three (3) public places in the City and also at the City Hall, not less than 15 days prior to the date set for the Election, and a substantial copy of this Ordinance also shall be published, both in English and in Spanish, on the same day in each of two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published in the City, the date of the first publication to be not less than 14 nor more than 30 days prior to the date set for the Election

SECTION 9. All resident qualified electors of the City shall be permitted to vote at the Election and on the day of the Election, such electors shall vote at the designated polling places. The Election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code, as amended, the City Charter, and the provisions of the Texas Government Code, and as may be required by any other law. All election materials and proceedings shall be printed in both English and Spanish

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SECTION 10. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be governed by the provisions of the City Charter and Section 1-15 of the City Code, respectively. As such, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately if passed by the affirmative vote of at least eight members of the City Council; otherwise, the same shall take effect on the tenth (10th) day after the date of its passage by the City Council.




