AN ORDINANCE
No. 482
Appropriating the sum of \$760.00 out of the 1922 General Fund (Contingencies Dept.) to be used as a compromise settlement on behalf of the City of San Antonio, of a suit styled "D.F. Cheatham et. ux. vs. City of San Antonio, et. al."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That the sum of \$760.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the 1922 General Fund (Contingencies Department) of the City of San Antonio to pay D.F. Cheatham, Carrie Cheatham, J.D. Childs and Heilbron and Mathews as a compromise settlement on behalf of the City of San Antonio, of the suit styled "D.F. Cheatham et ux vs. City of San Antonio et. al." in the 57th District Court of Bexar County, Texas.

SECTION TWO: The City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to prepare a warrant in said sum of \$760.00, payable to D.F. Cheatham, Carrie Cheatham, J.D. Childs and Heilbron and Mathews, and to deliver same to said parties upon their executing a legal and proper release to the City of San Antonio, fully and completely discharging and releasing said City of San Antonio from ~~an~~ and all liability arising from said suit or claim, said release to be approved as to form by the City ~~Attorney~~ Attorney of said City.
