REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES CONCERNED WITH THE DISPENSING OR SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON THE DAY OF CERTAIN ELECTIONS; AND ADOPTING THE PROVISIONS OF THE PENAL CODE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS AS CONTAINED IN THE TEXAS LIQUOR CONTROL ACT RE: THE DISPENSING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON ELECTION DAYS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:-

1. That all ordinances concerned with the dispensing or sale of alcoholic beverages on the day of certain elections are hereby repealed, and the enforcement of all prohibitions against the dispensing or sale of alcoholic beverages on election days shall come under the Penal Code of the State of Texas as contained in the Texas Liquor Control Act.
