

AN ORDINANCE 2011-11-03-0904

**AUTHORIZING TERM EXTENSIONS, ON MONTH-TO-MONTH BASIS,
FOR SEVERAL CONCESSIONS EXPIRING ON NOVEMBER 30, 2011
AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL.**

WHEREAS, concession agreements for the operation of several restaurants in San Antonio International Airport Terminal A and for airport-wide amenities will expire on November 30, 2011; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends the extension of the terms of these concession agreements on a month-to-month basis while it finalizes a strategy for solicitation of new operators for these concession locations; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The Aviation Director or his designee is authorized to execute term extensions, on a month-to-month basis, for Famous Famiglia, McDonald's, Creative Croissants, Las Palapas, Alamo City Microbrewery, Starbucks (Presecurity in Terminal A), shoe shine services, luggage carts and vending machines.

SECTION 2. The term extensions shall be in a form approved and recommended for execution by the City Attorney.

SECTION 3. Funds generated by this ordinance will be deposited into Fund 51001000 per the table below.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund

Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage by eight (8) affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective ten (10) days after its passage.






