

AN ORDINANCE **99026**

**AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 98892, PASSED ON FEBRUARY 26, 2004, TO REFLECT CHANGES IN ELECTION DAY POLLING SITES AND IN THE ENTITIES PARTICIPATING, AS APPLICABLE AND NECESSARY, IN THE SATURDAY, MAY 15, 2004 JOINT SPECIAL ELECTION.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 98892, passed and approved by the City of San Antonio City Council on February 26, 2004, ordered a Joint Special Election to be held on Saturday, May 15, 2004, and established the Election Day polling sites to be used in the Joint Special Election; and

**WHEREAS**, a number of the election day polling sites must now be changed due to voter accessibility issues and the unavailability of several sites; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 98892 ordered the May 15, 2004 Special Election to be held jointly with Bexar County, the Alamo Community College District, the East Central Independent School District, the Edgewood Independent School District, the North East Independent School District, and the San Antonio Independent School District; and

**WHEREAS**, the East Central Independent School District ("the ECISD") may cancel its trustee election scheduled to be conducted on May 15, 2004, and if so, the ECISD will no longer participate in the Joint Special Election; and

**WHEREAS**, it is now necessary to amend Ordinance No. 98892 to reflect changes in polling sites and in the entities participating, as applicable and necessary, in the May 15, 2004 Joint Special Election; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** Ordinance No. 98892, passed and approved on February 26, 2004, is hereby amended to reflect the changes in the polling sites to be used in the Saturday, May 15, 2004, Joint Special Election in accordance with **Attachments I & II**, which contain a list of election day polling site changes. Attachments I & II are attached hereto and are incorporated herein for all purposes.

**SECTION 2.** Ordinance No. 98892 is further authorized to be amended to reflect a change in the entities participating in the Saturday, May 15, 2004 Joint Special Election, should the East Central Independent School District cancel its trustee election scheduled to be conducted on Saturday, May 15, 2004.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance in order to transmit the information to the U.S. Department of Justice.


**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**
