

AN ORDINANCE **50612**

DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CANVASS OF THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON THE 7TH DAY OF APRIL, 1979, FOR MEMBER OF COUNCIL, PLACE NO. 6.

* * * * *

WHEREAS, the regular municipal election was held on the 7th day of April, 1979, to determine the Mayor and Council Members of the City of San Antonio for the ensuing term of office of two years; and

WHEREAS, the names of the candidates were submitted, the election was held and conducted and the returns thereof were made, all as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council met on April 9, 1979, in the City Council Chamber at City Hall to canvass the returns of the election for mayor and for all places on the City Council except that for Place No. 6, that individual race canvass being postponed pending a recount of the votes which had been requested by one of the candidates; and

WHEREAS, the recount of the votes for Member of Council, Place No. 6 was made on April 10, 1979, and the City Council met on April 12, 1979, to canvass the returns of that election; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

The City Council having convened on April 12, 1979, to canvass the returns of the regular city election held April 7, 1979, for Member of Council, Place No. 6, after canvassing the returns, does hereby find and declare that the result of the election is as follows:

For Member of Council, Place No. 6

"FOR" Bob Thompson.....	4,186
"FOR" Rudy C. Ortiz.....	4,102

It is further declared that as a result of said election, Bob Thompson was elected for a two year term commencing May 1, 1979, Member of Council, Place No. 6, by receiving a majority of all the votes cast for that office for which he was a candidate cast by the qualified voters voting in said election, and he is hereby declared to be the lawful and duly elected Council Member for the place specified.
