

AN ORDINANCE *08-35*

Amending Division Seven of an ordinance passed and approved on the eighth day of December A.D.1921 and entitled "An ordinance regulating the traffic on the streets, plazas and public places of the City of San Antonio, repealing all ordinances in conflict herewith and providing penalties", by adding Rule 40-a immediately after and following Rule 40 of said Division Seven.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION ONE: That Division Seven of a certain ordinance passed and approved on the eighth day of December A.D.1921 and entitled "An ordinance regulating the traffic on the streets, plazas and public places of the City of San Antonio, repealing all ordinances in conflict herewith and providing penalties." be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto Rule 40-a which Rule 40-a shall follow immediately after Rule 40 of said Division and shall read and provide as follows:

Rule 40-a. It shall be unlawful for any vehicle to park between the hours of eight A.M. and four P.M. upon the portions of the following streets hereinafter set out:

(a) On the south side of Romana Street along the portion thereof abutting the Main Avenue High School property, which portion of said street is designated and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the south line of Romana Street 138.3 west of its intersection with the west line of Main Avenue; THENCE in a westerly direction with the south line of Romana Street a distance of 216.2 feet.

(b) On the west side of Main Avenue along the portion thereof abutting the Main Avenue High School property, which portion of said Main Avenue is designated and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the west line of Main Avenue 121 feet south of its intersection with the south line of Romana Street; THENCE south along the west line of Main Avenue a distance of 184.4 feet.

(c) On the west side of Garden Street along the portion thereof abutting the Brackenridge High School property, which portion of said Garden Street is designated and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the west side of Garden Street where the same intersects with the south line of Marne Street; THENCE in a southerly direction with the said west line of Garden Street, a distance of 639.1 feet.

(d) On the south side of Marne Street along the portion thereof abutting the Brackenridge High School property, which portion of said street is designated and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the south line of Marne Street where the same intersects the west line of Garden Street and extending in a westerly direction along the south line of Marne Street a distance of 850.4 feet.

SECTION TWO: The provisions and restrictions in the foregoing Rule shall not apply on any day when the public schools are not actually in session within the City of San Antonio.

SECTION THREE: Any person violating any of the provisions of Section One and Two of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine in any sum not to exceed One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for the second or any subsequent offense by a fine of not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars nor more than Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars.

SECTION FOUR: This ordinance is hereby declared to be of urgent importance for reasons of public welfare apparent herefrom and same shall take effect immediately after its passage.
