

MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

MONDAY, AUGUST 11TH, A.D.1919, 4 P.M.

PRESENT: Honorable Ray Lambert, Mayor Pro-tem, presiding, and Commissioners Coy, Heuermann, Wright. Absent, Mayor Bell.

Minutes of previous meeting were ordered approved.

---MEMORIALS AND PETITIONS---

Petition of Ben P. Lane, Atty for West Texas Conference M.E.Church South, requesting exemption of certain property from taxation, was read and referred to Commissioner of Taxation.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Fire and Police: Grover C. Cain, for permit to build a drive-in filling station at Carolina and S. Presa Sts.

San Pedro Garage, for permit to erect gasoline tank and pump, 523 San Pedro Avenue.

Martin Wright Electric Co. for permit to erect electric sign for Mayo's Exchange, Commerce and Casino Sts.

Stearns-Knight Garage, for permit to erect gasoline pump and tank at intersection of Romana and Agusta Sts.

For arc lamp at Colima and S. Brazos Streets.

The following petitions were read and referred to Commissioner of Streets and Public Improvements:

For improvement of Hood and Shirley Streets.

To macadamize Furnish Avenue.

For improvement of Delgado Street.
